GOVERNOR TO SIGN LAW CREATING INCENTIVES FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF VACANT INDUSTRIAL SITES

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will be joined by legislative sponsors and others in Edgewater (Bergen County) for the signing of legislation that will expedite the cleanup of brownfields property.

The new law will provide incentives for the expedited clean up of vacant commercial, industrial and other properties, and will help to revitalize urban areas and ease commercial and industrial expansion in the suburbs.

The Governor will sign the legislation at the former ALCOA factory site which is currently being remediated and redeveloped into a 460-unit luxury apartment complex. Crews are currently working on the site to demolish the ALCOA infrastructure.
