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**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES**  
**AUGUST 1998**

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Comparing counts for August 31, 1998 with those on August 31, 1997, the following changes are noted:

**RESIDENTS**

7% increase from 27,485 to 29,470 for the jurisdictional population;  
(state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);  
-31% decrease from 4,356 to 3,336 for state inmates in county facilities;  
17% increase from 18,219 to 21,405 for the prison complex;  
-4% decrease from 4,910 to 4,729 for the youth facilities.

**ADMISSIONS**

-3% decrease from 1,298 to 1,254 for total admissions.

**RELEASES**

-10% decrease from 1,188 to 1,064 for total releases;  
-24% decrease from 793 to 603 for male parole releases;  
-8% decrease from 74 to 68 for female parole releases;  
-23% decrease from 867 to 671 for total parole releases;  
4% increase from 321 to 333 for offenders discharged at max.

**NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
