**ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS**  
**JANUARY 1994**

Compared to the trimester ending January 31, 1993 Admissions for trimester ending January 31, 1994 were:

- Down 7% from 2734 to 2532 for the Prison;
- Down 18% from 214 to 175 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility;
- Down 58% from 114 to 48 for the Youth Complex; and
- Up 33% from 236 to 313 for Juvenile Facilities.

Resident counts on January 31, 1994 compared to the end of January 31, 1993 were:

- Up 6% from 22,260 to 23,630 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Up 24% from 2971 to 3696 for County Waiting;
- Up 6% from 22,824 to 24,258 for all Institutions;
- Up 1% from 13,977 to 14,124 for the Prison;
- Up 10% from 4449 to 4884 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Up 8% from 559 to 601 for Juvenile Facilities.

**NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ **PAROLE RELEASES** are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ **MEDIUM/MAX UNITS:** Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
