REPORT.

Office of the State Librarian, Trenton, N. J., Nov. 1st, 1890.

To His Excellency Leon Abbett, Governor of New Jersey:

SIR—Permit me to submit the following report of the condition of the State Library, for the fiscal year ending October 31st, 1890.

At the time of my last annual report, the whole number of books, papers, magazines and pamphlets in the Library was 36,067. During the past year, the following additions have been made by exchange, donation and purchase, as particularly specified in the appendix:

By exchange from other States and Canada	202

Making the whole number of books, pamphlets, magazines, &c., now in the Library, 37,146.

Included in the number of law books are 51 volumes of the pamphlet laws of other States, purchased to complete our set, which is one of the most perfect in the country.

During the year, 247 books and pamphlets and 21 newspaper files have been bound, and 14 volumes have been re-bound, while others are being repaired.

During the last four months the Miscellaneous Library has been partially closed to the public, on account of the unsafe condition of

the ceiling of the gallery in which it is located, although we have admitted several gentlemen, engaged in historical research, who were willing to take the risk. Although large quantities of the heavy moulding have fallen at various times, fortunately no one has been hurt.

As your Excellency is aware, the spacious rooms of the third story of the new fire-proof front of the State House are being fitted up for the removal of the Library to safe and commodious quarters, and I think I can assure you that the removal will be perfected before the first of January next. The location will cause some inconvenience to the courts and older members of the bar, on account of the difficult stairway from the second story, but it is hoped this objection will, in time, be remedied by an elevator. At all events, almost any inconvenience ought to be submitted to, in view of the fact that the removal of the Library to its proposed locality will secure it from the risk of destruction with which it is now constantly menaced. When the Library is arranged in its new quarters, it will be pronounced one of the finest "working" libraries in the country, either in its law or miscellaneous department.

Inventors and pottery decorators will be particularly pleased with the new arrangement, as our complete set of patent reports, instead of being inconveniently piled upon tables, will have ample shelf-room in the northwest corner of the Miscellaneous Library, while the Librarian's room, with a fine northern light and convenient tableroom, will afford desirable accommodation to those interested in our valuable art books.

Although the Library was partially closed for several months, as above stated, the number of registered visitors during the year, exclusive of members of the bar, State officials and other regular attendants, amounted to 2,550, or within 250 of the year previous.

The accompanying appendix presents an itemized statement of the additions to the Library since my last report.
