

**Weihenmayer Fall Festival Speaker**

On September 8th Erik Weihenmayer, the mountain climber who just successfully climbed Mt. Everest, will be the featured speaker at the Library's Fall Festival this year at 11 a.m. Weihenmayer will discuss his assault on Everest as well as talk about his other ascents and how he has never let his blindness prevent him from achieving his dreams. His book, *Touch the Top of the World* (RC 51505, B 3495) is biographical and was written prior to his Everest climb. In this adventure-packed memoir, he recalls rebelling against becoming blind by age fifteen and relates acquiring a passion for mountaineering and developing the character traits that enabled him to succeed.


