The Institute of Museum and Library Services is now accepting FY 2019 proposals for these two programs. New this year, IMLS is offering one application deadline for the two programs, which have previously each had two cycles per year. Applicants have through Sept. 17 to submit their two-page preliminary proposals. Three pre-application webinars will be held on June 25, July 10 and July 25 with program staff.
