Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

While the expected results for March 2020 and forward will show a precipitous drop in passenger activity, February gifted us with growth thanks in part to the extra day due to this leap year. The volume of the region's air travelers set a new record for the month of February with 9.689 million passengers (+380,869 travelers/+4.1 percent). As in the month of January, the domestic sector paced growth with a new mark of 6.469 million travelers (+373,954 passengers/+6.1 percent). International passenger activity inched up to a record 3.22 million travelers (+0.2 percent/+6,915 passengers). For the ninth successive month, the region's total cargo traffic fell (-6.3) percent/-10,394 tons). The domestic sector (accounting for nearly 40 percent of our airports' total freight volume) led with a fall of 8.7 percent (-5,393 tons). International cargo continues to struggle (-5 percent/-5,149 tons).
