SUBJECT: Increased Income Standards for JerseyCare

The 1988 Federal Poverty Income Guidelines were published in the Federal Register on February 12, 1988. Therefore, in accordance with the JerseyCare Manual (N.J.A.C. 10:72-4.1), the income standards for the JerseyCare program will increase effective April 1, 1988. The new standards appearing below apply equally to aged, blind, and disabled persons as well as pregnant women and children under the age of two years:
