

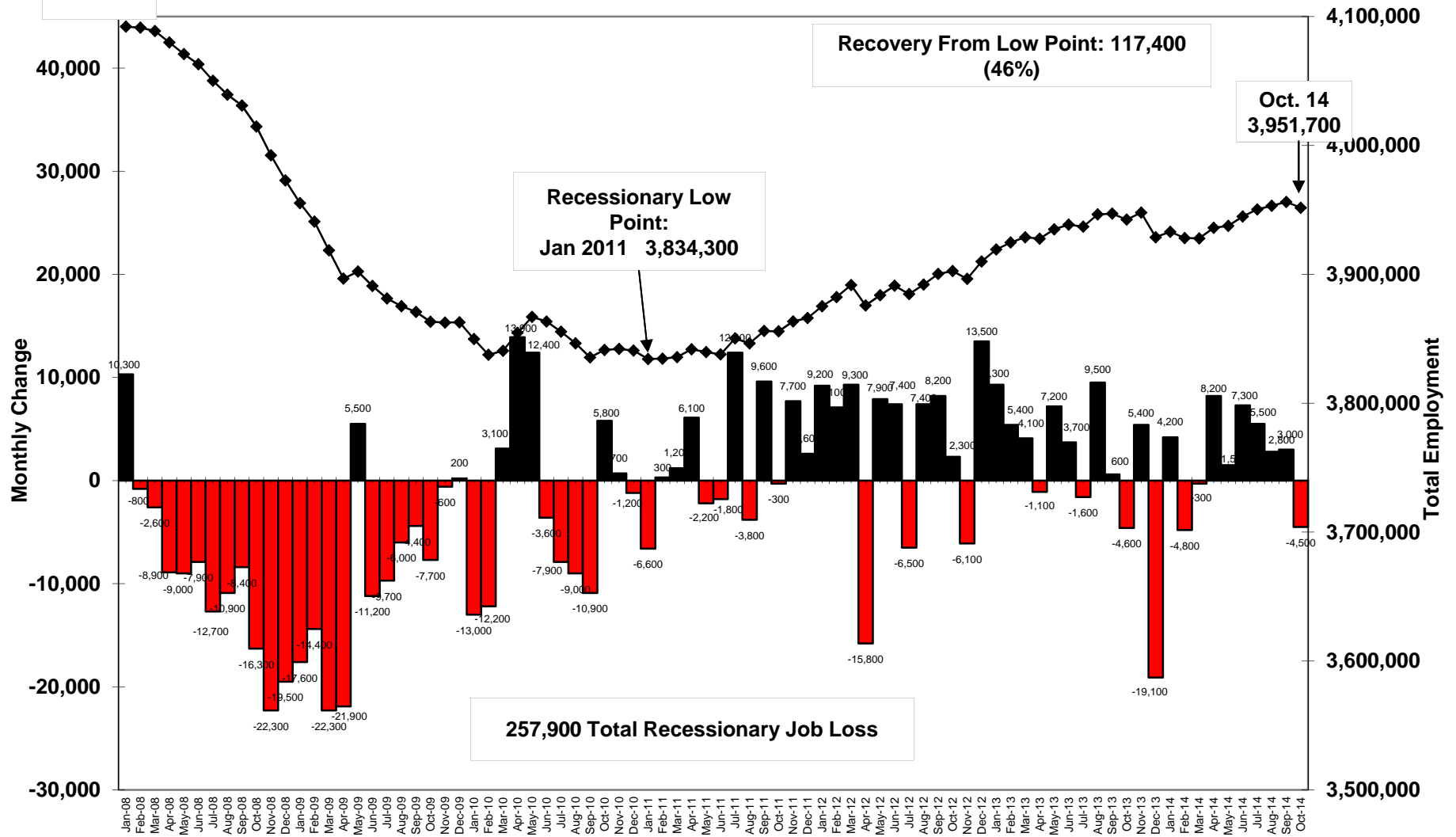

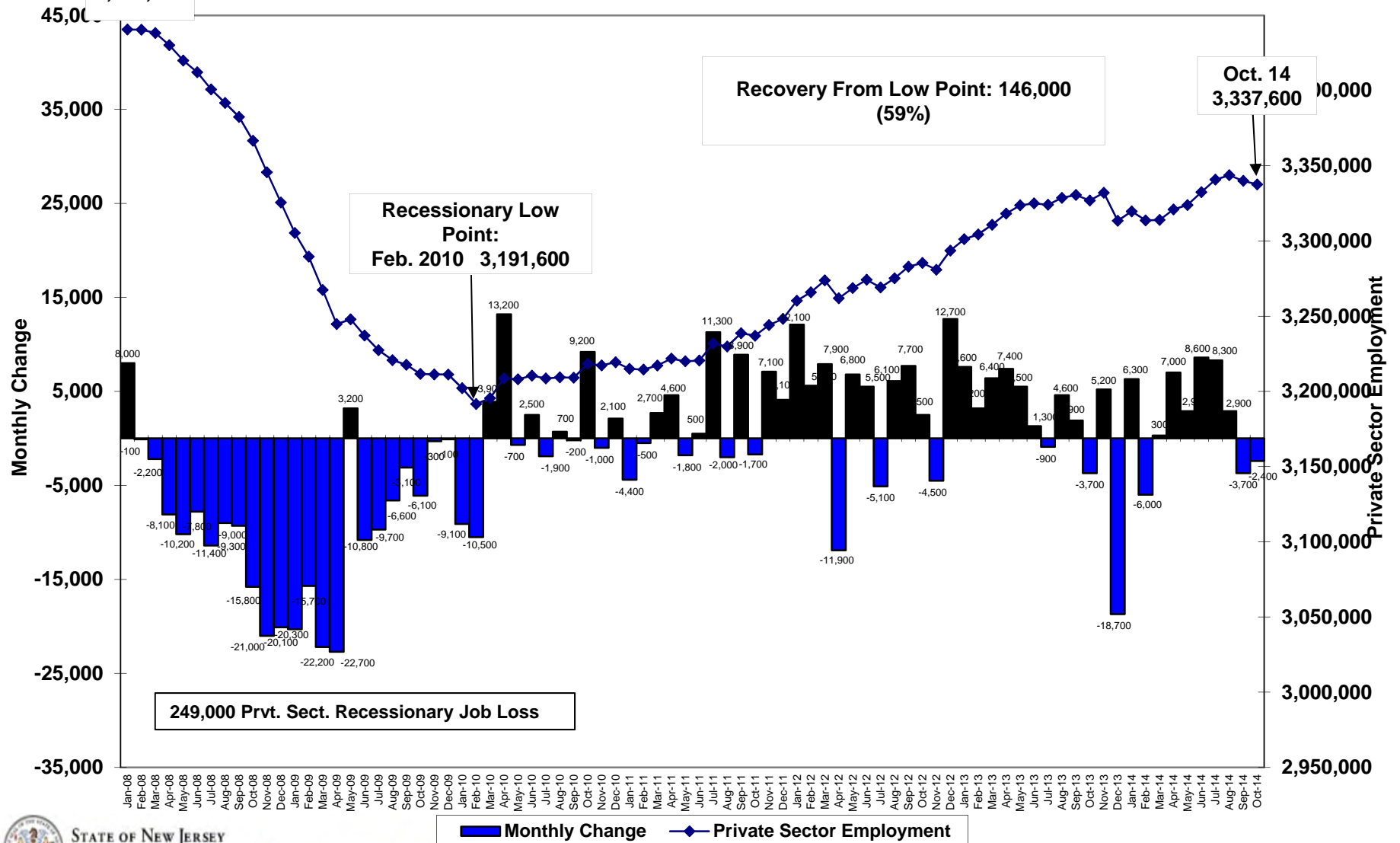


New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - October 2014

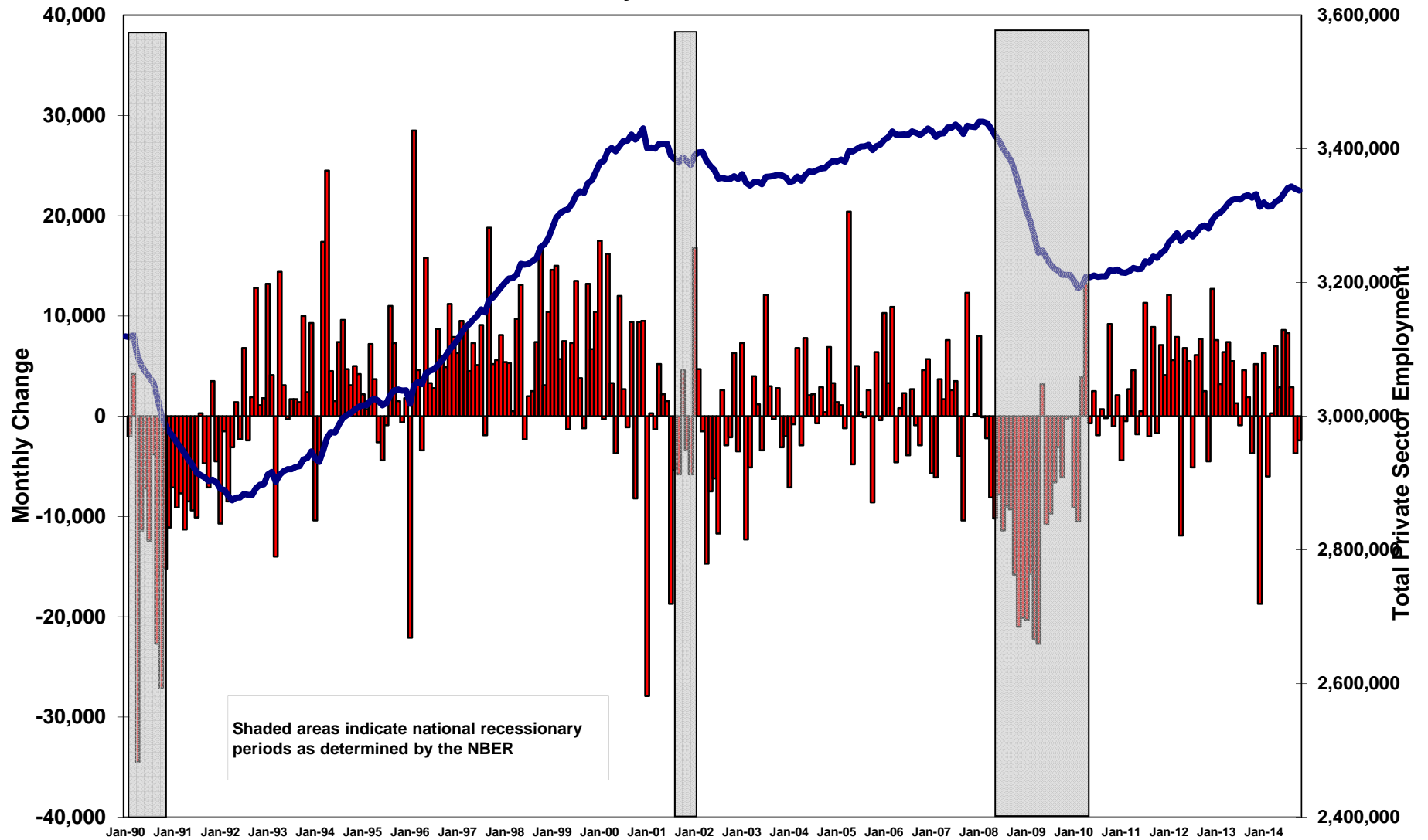

New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 1990 - October 2014



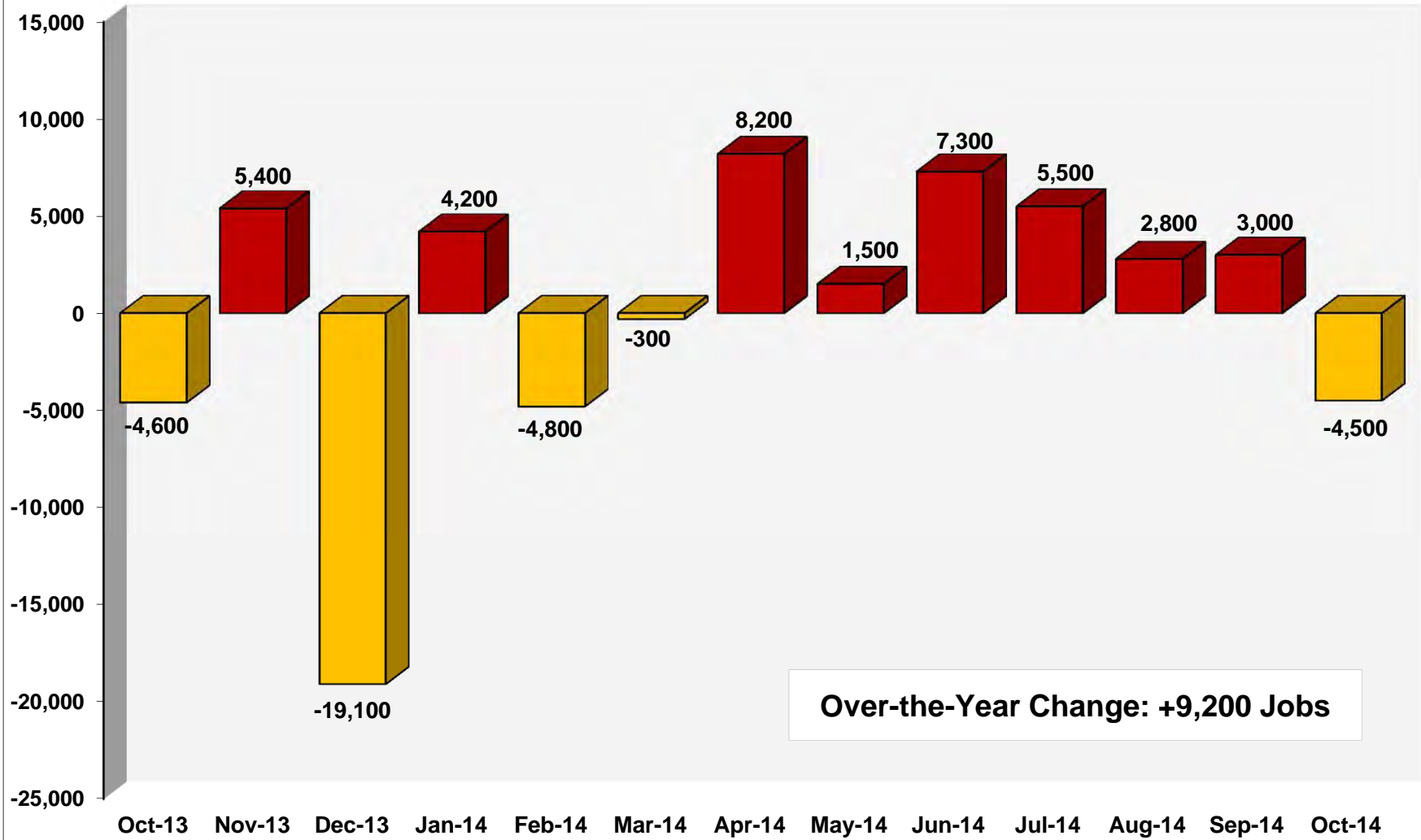

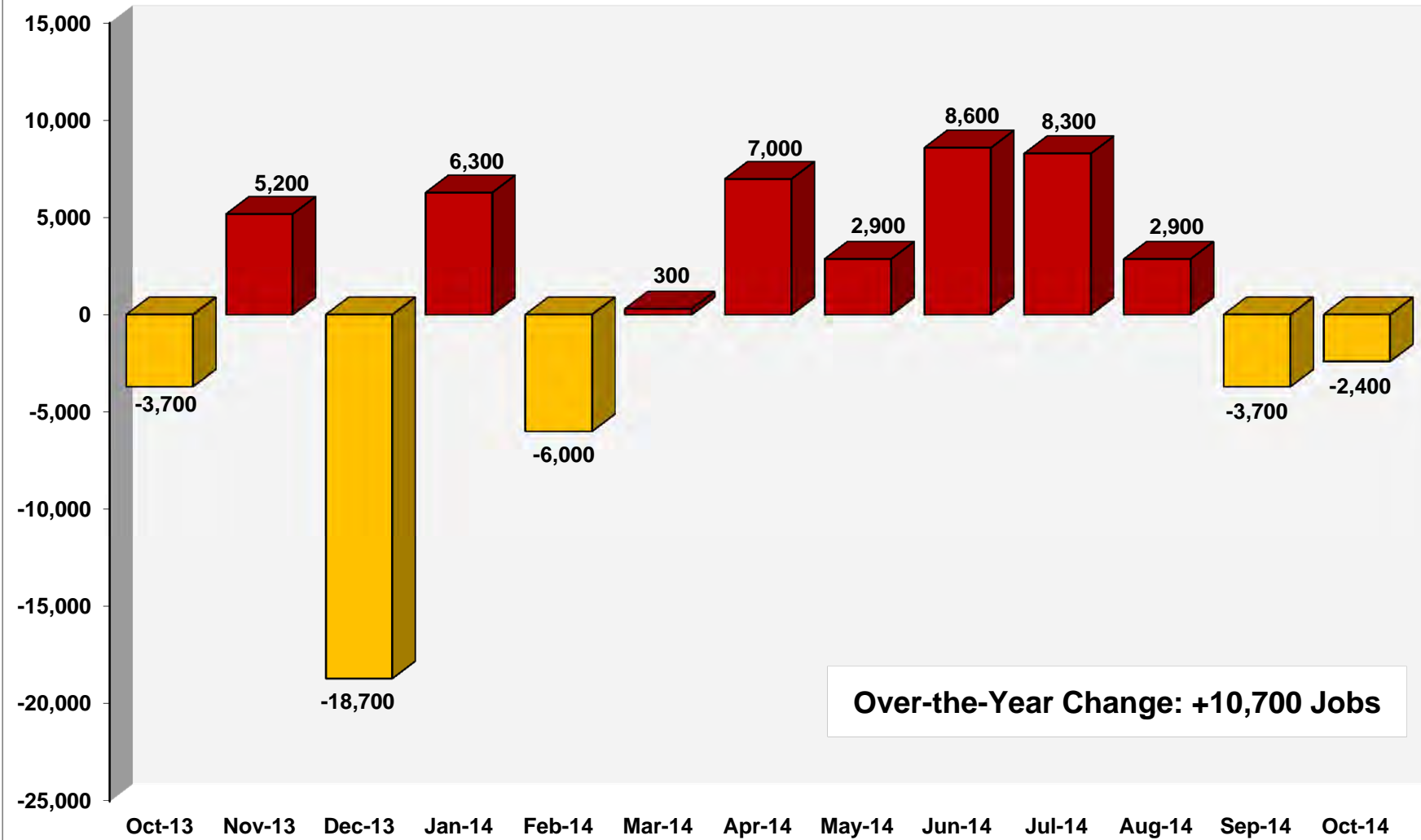

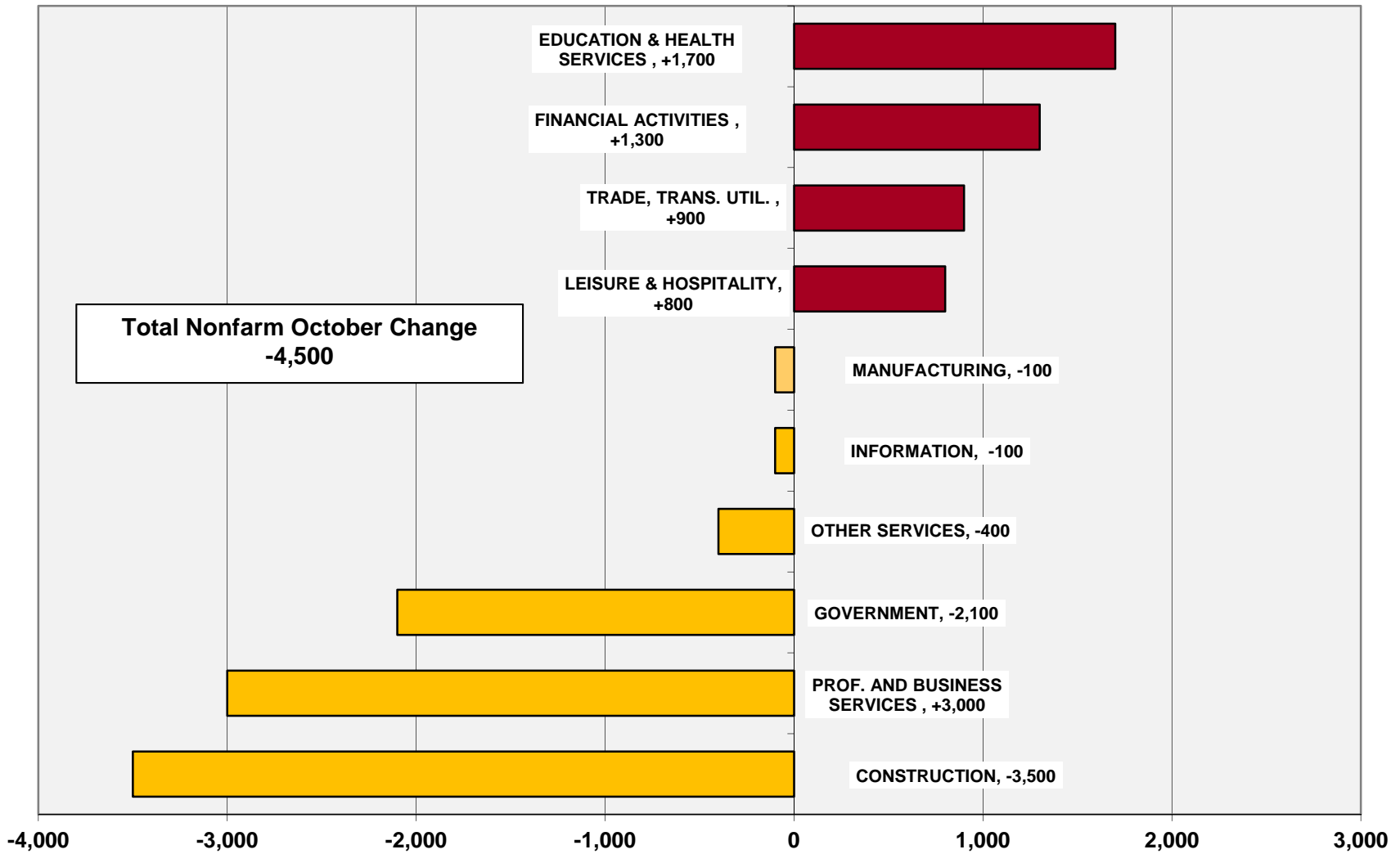
Monthly Total Employment Change New Jersey: October 2013 - October 2014



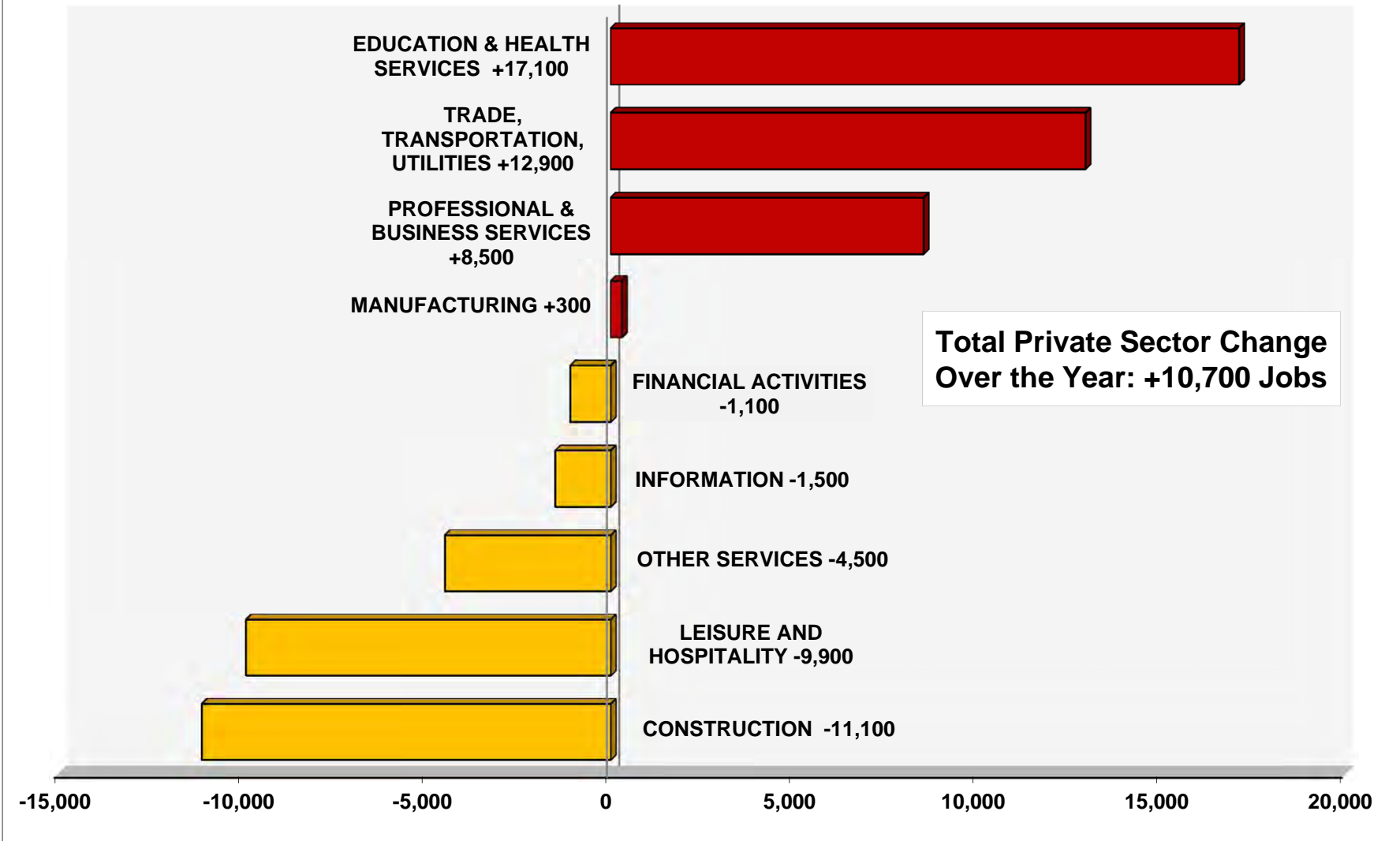
Monthly Private Sector Employment Change October 2013 - October 2014



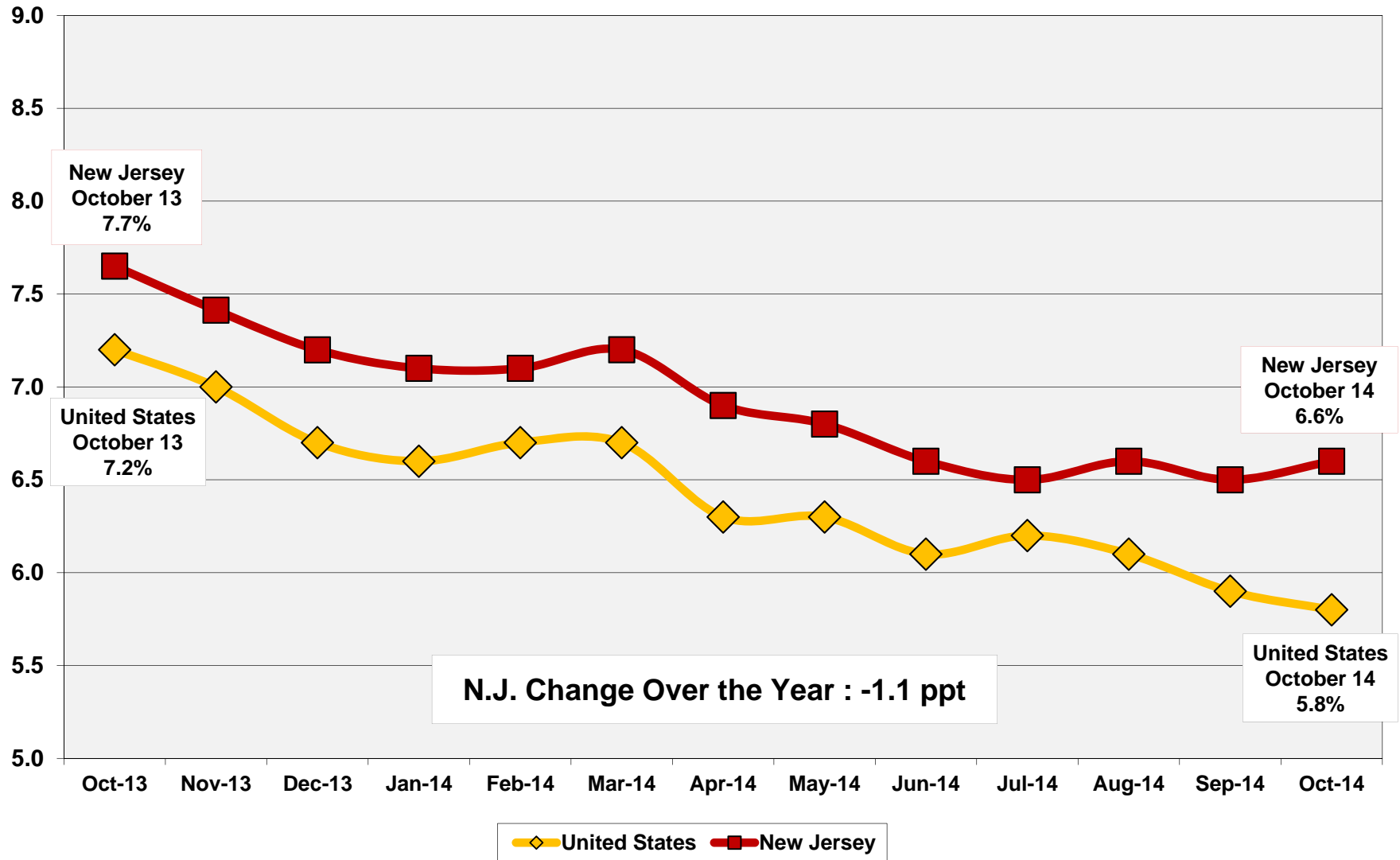
Monthly Employment Change: October 2014



New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry October 2013 - October 2014



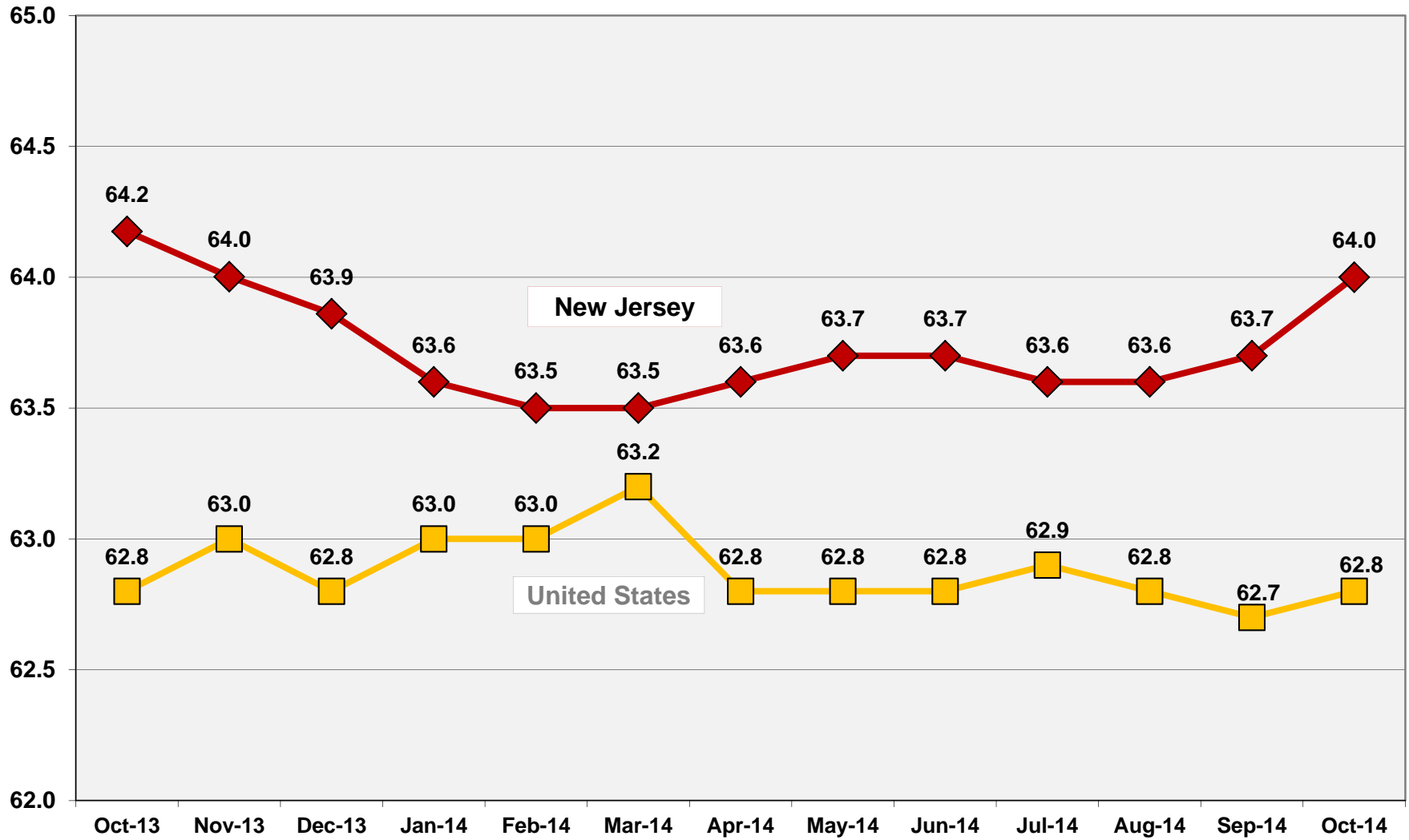
Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States: October 2013 - October 2014



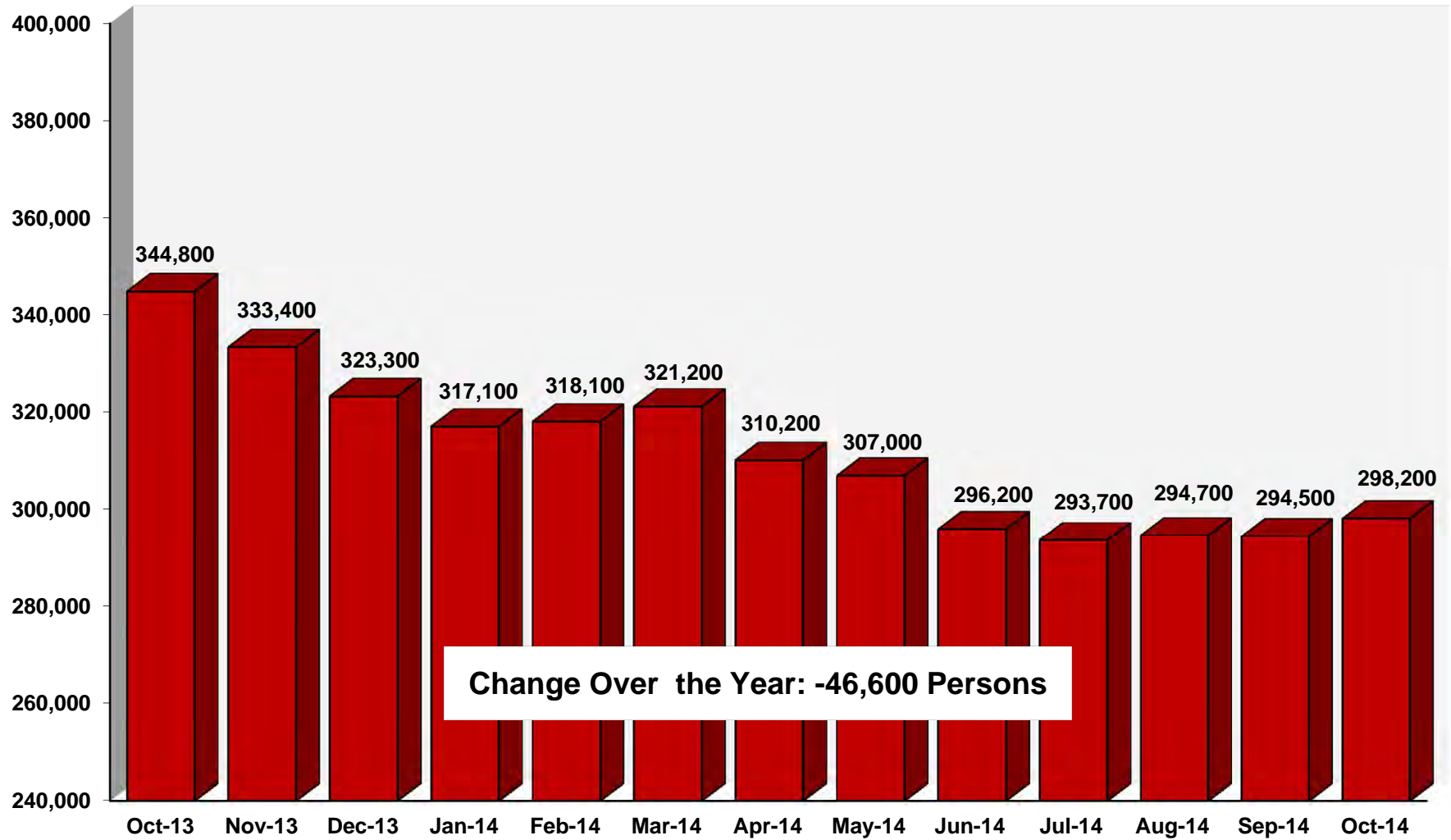

New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: October 2013 - October 2014



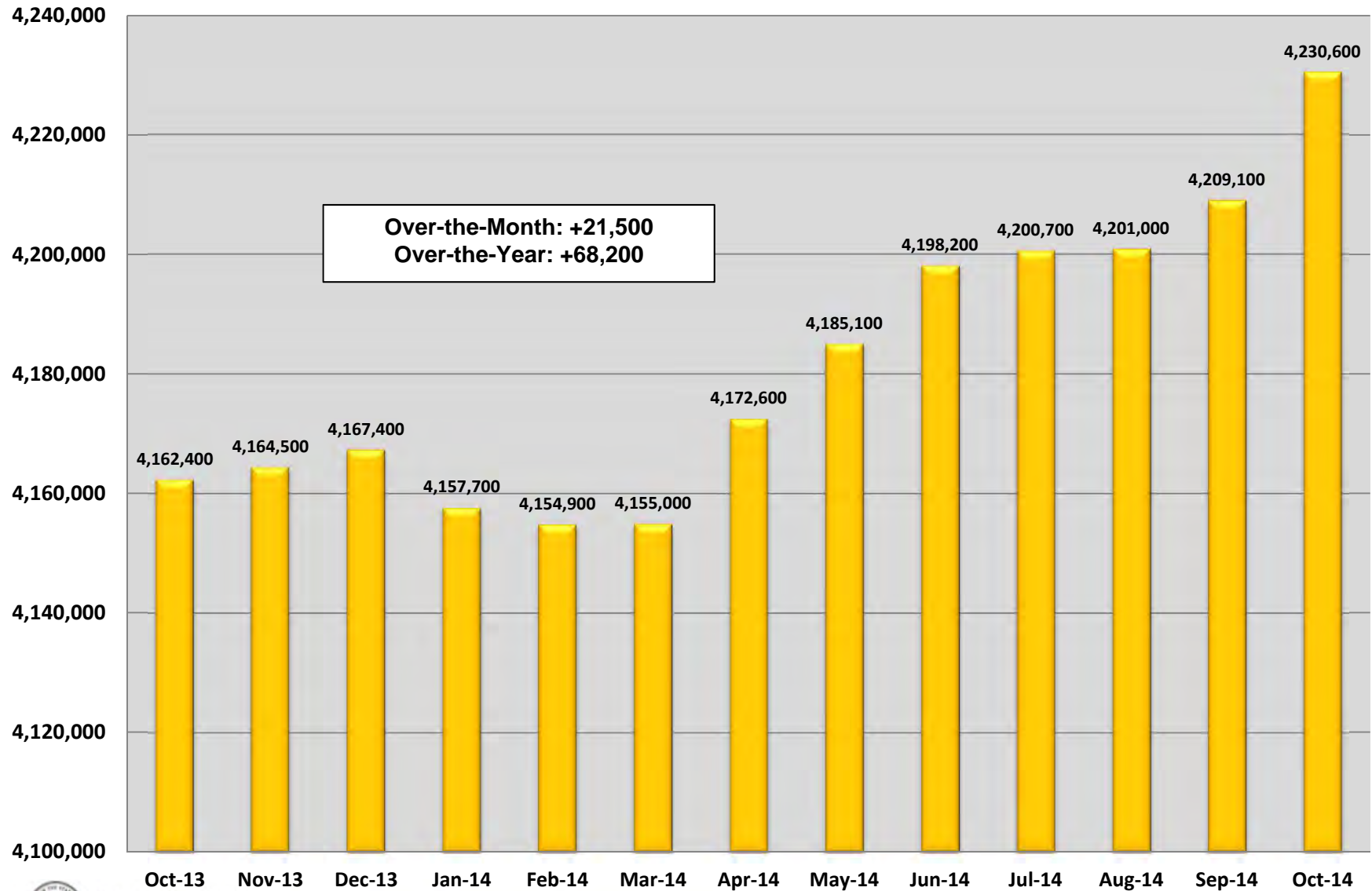
Unemployed New Jersey Residents October 2013 - October 2014

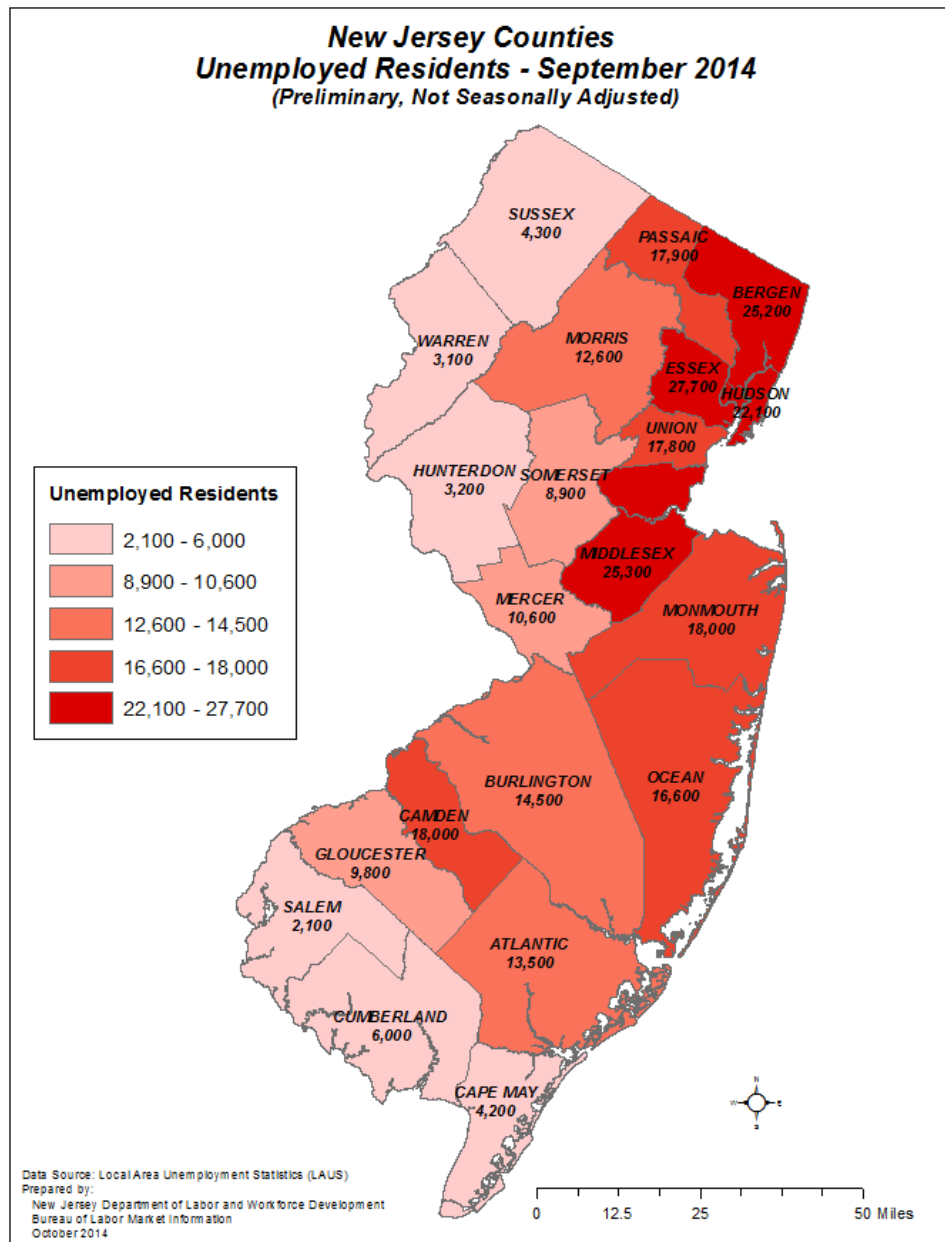

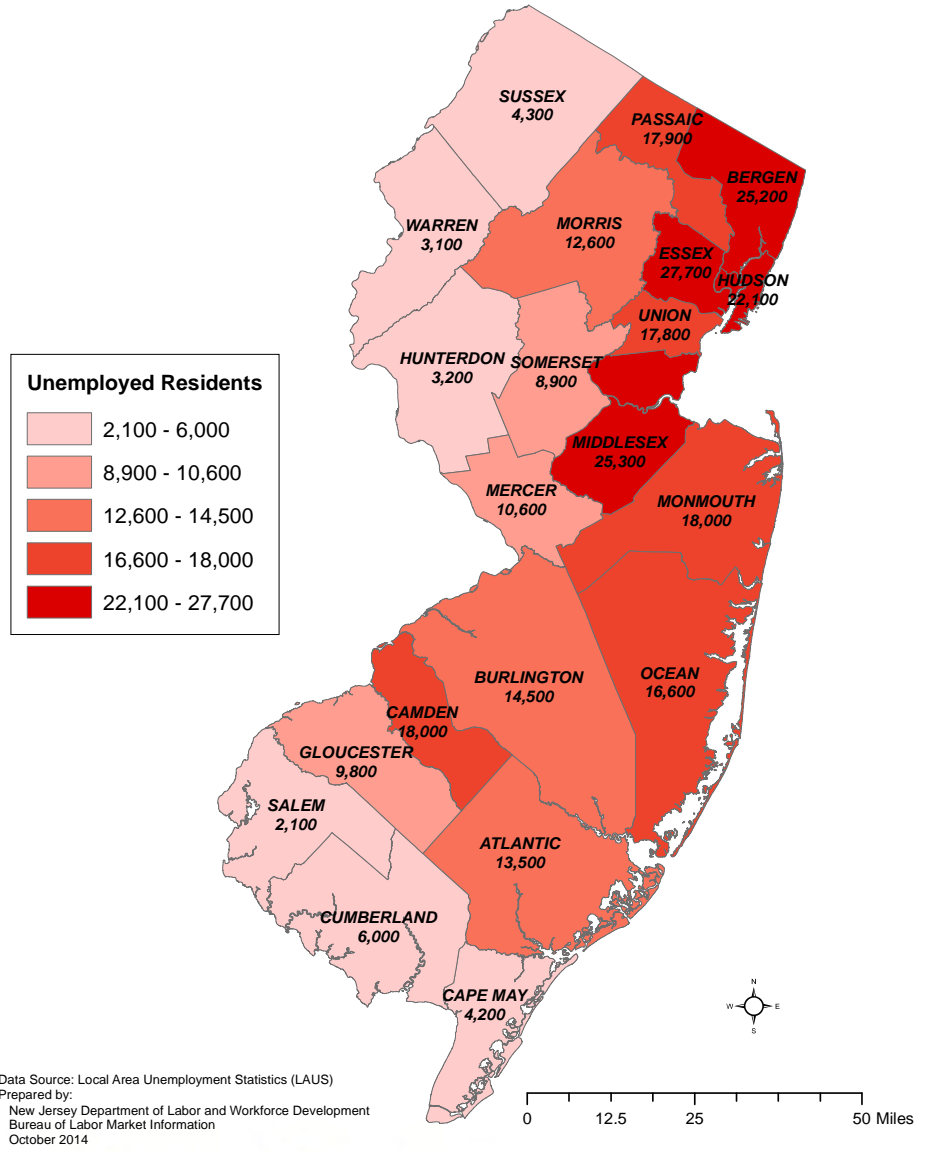

New Jersey Counties Unemployed Residents - September 2014 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)



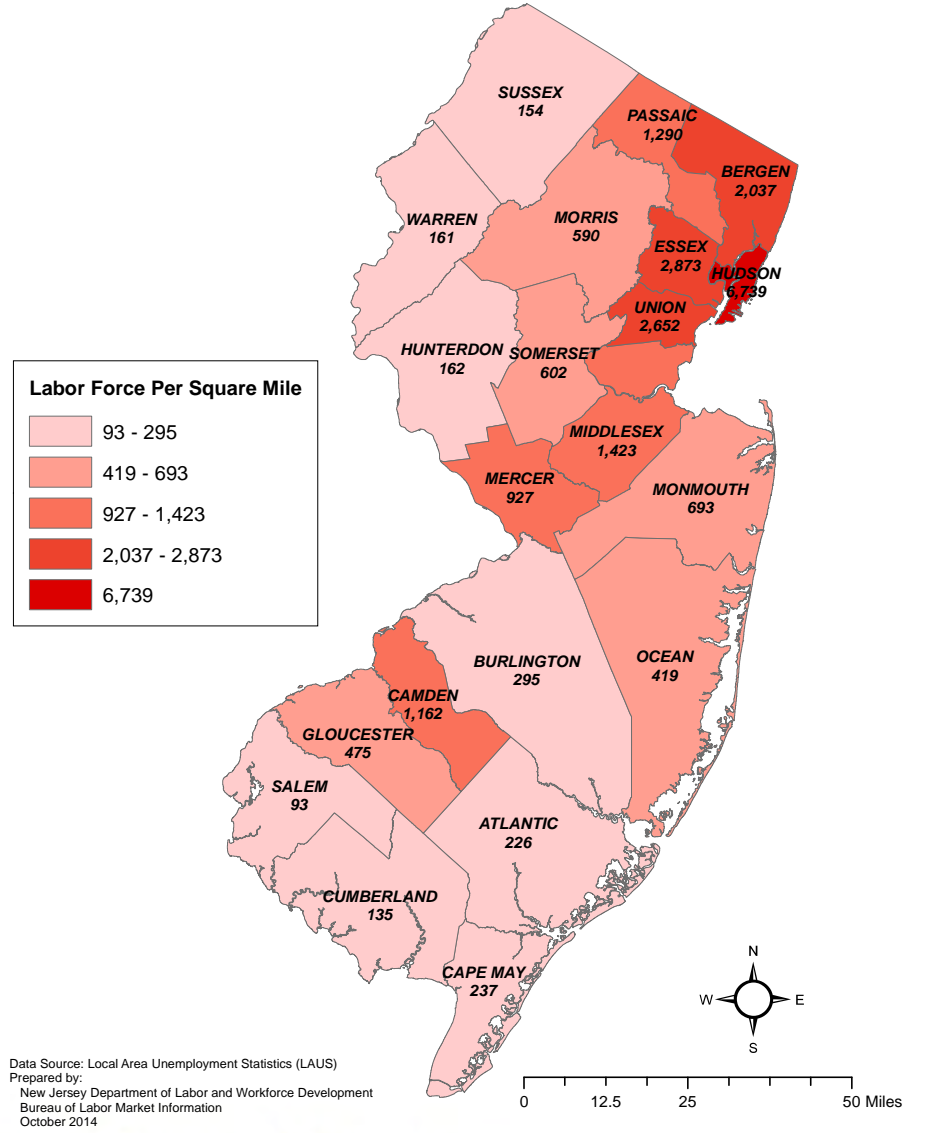

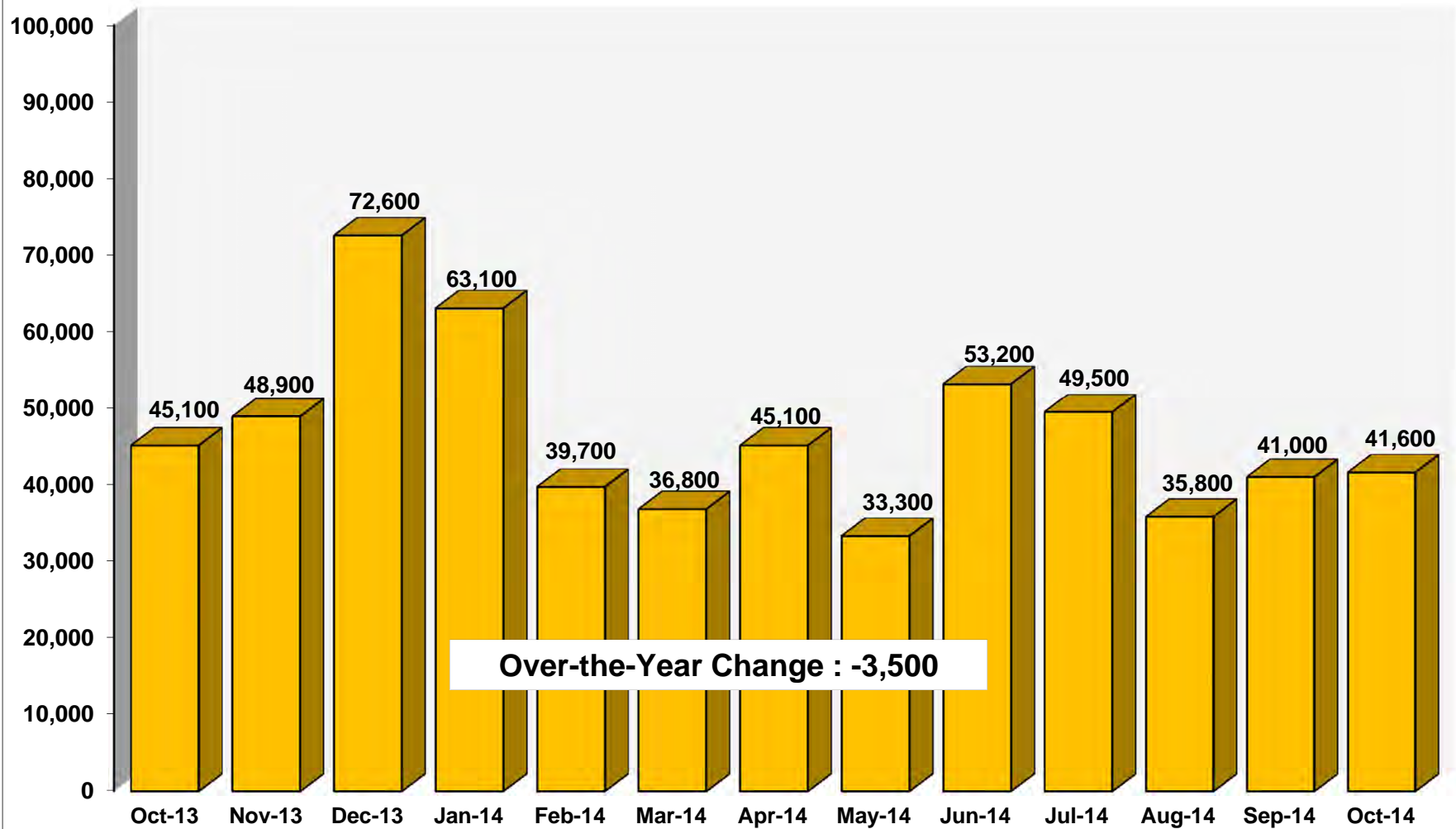
