### **Governor Nominates Middlesex County Prosecutor**

Gov. Christie Whitman today nominated Glenn Berman of East Brunswick to be prosecutor of Middlesex County.

"Glenn Berman's extensive legal experience as a municipal prosecutor, judge and public servant will provide him with the unique perspective needed to be the chief law enforcement officer of Middlesex County," said Gov. Whitman. "I am confident that the people of that county will be well-served by his commitment to public safety."

Berman has served as Superior Court judge since 1989. He graduated from Case Western Reserve Law School and received his undergraduate degree from Gettysburg College.

Prior to his appointment as a judge, Berman was an attorney in private practice concentrating in civil litigation and real estate. While in private practice, he also served as prosecutor, special prosecutor, or attorney for the zoning board or governing body in the municipalities of Monroe, South River, Old Bridge, East Brunswick, South Brunswick and Helmetta. He was elected to the South River Council in 1975, re-elected in 1978, and served as council president in 1980.

Berman has served on the County Ethics Committee and chaired the New Jersey State and Middlesex County Bar Associations sections on real estate and municipal courts.

Berman is married and has two children.
