## Teterboro & regional satellite airport summaries

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The February 11 blizzard played havoc with traffic, causing a loss of about 3,500 flight movements or 4.7% of the regional total based on control tower records.

Nevertheless, passengers increased 1.8% -just under 3 percentage points higher than the American Transport

Association average. Newark led with 8.9% growth, with

JFK and LGA in the negative one to two percent range.

Regional freight fell (2.9%).
