**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES  
DECEMBER 1996**

Comparing counts for December 31, 1996 with those on December 31, 1995, the following changes are noted:

**RESIDENTS**

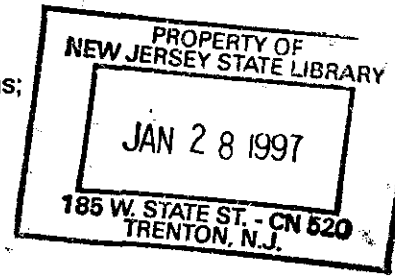
- 2% increase from 27,341 to 27,799 for all institutions;
- 2% increase from 26,584 to 27,001 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 3% increase from 4,258 to 4,367 for county waiting;
- -3% decrease from 1040 to 1006 for county contract and county assistance;
- 4% increase from 15,711 to 16,410 for the prison complex;
- -6% decrease from 5,575 to 5,218 for the youth facilities; and
- 5% increase from 757 to 798 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

**ADMISSIONS**

- 1% increase from 1,117 to 1,130 for total admissions;
- 2% increase from 1,010 to 1,033 for adults; and
- -9% decrease from 107 to 97 for juveniles.

**RELEASES**

- 35% increase from 950 to 1,283 for total releases;
- 30% increase from 596 to 775 for adult male parole releases;
- 56% increase from 59 to 92 for adult female parole releases;
- 32% increase from 655 to 867 for total adult parole releases;
- 36% increase from 209 to 284 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 53% increase from 86 to 132 for juvenile releases.



**NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS**

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
