

JANUARY 1, 2014**

The job categories listed below require a minimum of master's level or significant technical expertise. Failure to exempt these positions would seriously impede the ability of Camden County College to compete successfully with similar colleges in other states. (This category exemption report is accompanied by a list of specific titles).

All faculty positions	Faculty positions require subject matter credentials, including master prepared individuals, and often require additional expertise within a discipline.
Executive/Administrative	Camden County College often encounters recruitment challenges when searching for positions that require a master's degree. Relevant experience is also essential; further narrowing the pool of candidates. Although the vast majority of our employees live in NJ, we need the flexibility of hiring qualified candidates who live in contiguous states when necessary.
Temporary Part Time Per Semester Positions	Camden County College utilizes part time employees on an "as needed" basis during the semester for tutoring, science lab assistants, computer lab assistants, note taking for students with disabilities and similar type positions. Temporary part time employees receive no benefits and help maintain low tuition costs for students. An exemption for temporary part time employees will help continue low tuition.
