GOVERNOR NOMINATES PATRICIA TALBERT FOR SUPERIOR COURT

Gov. Christie Whitman today submitted to the state Senate her intention to nominate Patricia Medina Talbert, of South Orange, for the Superior Court of New Jersey. Talbert is the first Asian American woman to be nominated to serve on the Superior Court of New Jersey.

Talbert is a partner in the firm of Walder, Sondak & Brogan, of Roseland, where she is engaged in the practice of employment law and commercial litigation. From 1990 to 1993, she served in the Department of Law and Public Safety as a Special Assistant to the Attorney General and as a Deputy Attorney General.

A graduate of the Rutgers School of Law, Newark, she is a co-founder and past president of the Asian-Pacific American Lawyers Association of New Jersey.
