### NJ250 Exhibit: New Tour Dates for September

The New Jersey State Library has existed since 1796, 20 years after our first State Constitution was ratified on July 2, 1776. State Library staff have curated themed collection items that tell a story within each of New Jersey's Constitutional eras. Our collections capture the social, political, and legal conditions of each of the three state Constitutional eras: Revolutionary (1776-1844), Reform (1844-1947), and Modern (1947-Present).



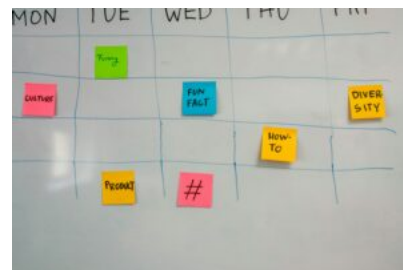
Each of the three display cases represents a state Constitutional era and follows a different theme. Learn more about the documents on display [here](#).

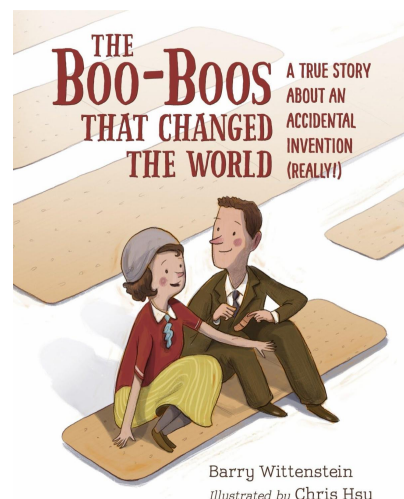

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## NJ Expands Job-Protected Leave for Workers

If you have patrons coming in seeking information about Temporary Disability and Family Leave Insurance, the New Jersey Division on Civil Rights (DCR) and the Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL) have recently announced changes to New Jersey law that will expand job-protected leave for many workers across the state. Changes to state law significantly expand job-protected leave by extending protections to workers receiving benefits through New Jersey's Temporary Disability Insurance (TDI) and Family Leave Insurance (FLI) programs, when their leave is not already covered under the New Jersey Family Leave Act (NJFLA) or the federal Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA).
