Dear Mr. Porroni:

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14-7.a., on behalf of Rowan University, I am pleased to provide you with the list of titles to be exempted from the New Jersey residency requirement. In keeping with the language of the exemption provision, we believe that these titles represent those that would most likely require "special expertise or extraordinary qualifications in an academic, scientific, technical, professional, or medical field or in administration, that, if not exempt from the residency requirement, would seriously impede the ability of the college, university, or institution to compete successfully with similar colleges, universities, or institutions in other states."

Please note that we were very careful in developing this list. The administration and Trustees at Rowan University believe in the spirit of the residency requirement and we do not offer these exempted titles cavalierly. We believe that it is, in fact, important for employees of Rowan University to reside in New Jersey and in some cases, reside in the town in which we are located. However, given our close proximity to Philadelphia/Pennsylvania and Delaware, we find that we are in strong competition with numerous colleges and universities that populate this region. As you are undoubtedly aware, the city of Philadelphia ranks at the top or near the top of cities most populated with higher educational institutions in the country.

Of particular urgency is the opening of our new medical school this coming fall. We are in the process of searching for medical school faculty, and given our proximity to the teaching hospitals and medical centers in Philadelphia, we expect numerous applicants and successful candidates to come from this arena. The requirement to relocate families and in some cases, practices to New Jersey would present problems for many of these individuals and would impact our competitiveness in attracting the best and brightest to the medical school.
