Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Every year has its challenges, but 2011 was exceptional. Multiple blizzards shut down our airports by dumping snowfalls that were measured in feet instead of inches, and we had a month that featured a major hurricane and an earthquake. Despite all these negative developments, the Port Authority's airport system continued to demonstrate its resilience, with 1.8 percent more passengers. However, cargo declined 2.3%.
