Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

Total passenger volume reached a record 13.245 million travelers (+422,105 passengers/+3.3 percent), making August the busiest month ever in the history of the Port Authority's airport operations—as a region and for two of the three major airports—dating back to 1947. All three major airports set new August records (and all-time monthly records for JFK and LGA). The domestic sector set the pace with a record 8.090 million passengers (+314,740 passengers/+4 percent). Similarly, the international sector reached a new mark of 5.155 million passengers (+107,365 travelers/+2.1 percent). Carriers grew total seats by 2.7 percent: domestic by 3.9 percent, and international by 0.9 percent. For the first time since July 2016, total freight fell (-0.06 percent/-120 tons). International cargo, which represents over 60 percent of the region's total freight traffic, decreased 3 percent (-3,733 tons). In contrast, domestic freight grew at a robust 5.3 percent pace (+3,613).
