Let us not forget the lessons of that horrific day, especially the debt we owe to all our service members who have kept our homeland safe and who continue to protect our freedoms at home and abroad today."

Governor Christie also proclaimed today "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day" throughout New Jersey.
