Gov. Christie Whitman today filed with the State Senate notice of her intention to nominate Maryann K. Bielamowicz of Pennington as a Superior Court Judge.

Bielamowicz served as Mercer County Prosecutor from 1992 until last month. As prosecutor, Bielamowicz's primary focus was on youth in the corrections system, including juvenile justice, crime prevention and education, Megan's Law and children as victims.

Prior to her appointment as prosecutor, she served as First Assistant Prosecutor since 1988, and as Assistant Prosecutor from 1976-86. She was an associate with the Newark law firm of McCarter & English from 1986-88. Bielamowicz has served as President of the Prosecutors' Association and a trustee of the Mercer County Bar Association.

Bielamowicz received her undergraduate degree from Rider University and her law degree from Villanova University School of Law.
