TRANSCRIPT

Governor Christie: I still have two children in elementary school, one in sixth grade and one in fourth grade, so I'm in this father business for a while and I hope someday, God willing, to be in the grandfather business. And so it's just their presence, and knowing that you're getting older, and you want to be around for them. People in public life have the same concerns that people in private life have. You know this is no different. And just because I have a public office and I have some measure of notoriety doesn't mean that my feelings about my family and my concerns about their future are any different than yours or anybody else who's sitting here.
