Gov. Whitman to Address Governor's Conference on Women in Atlantic City, Take Tour of Margate and Camden to Discuss Need for Open Space and Historic Preservation

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will visit park sites in Margate and Camden to discuss the importance of parks and open space in New Jersey.

The Governor will tour the future site of Waterfront Park on the Margate waterfront, the Walt Whitman House and the Wiggins Waterfront Park, both in Camden. The Governor will be joined at Wiggins Waterfront Park by students from the U.S. Wiggins School in Camden.

Gov. Whitman will also speak at the Governor's Conference on Women in Atlantic City, where she will announce the Governor's Leadership Award winners. The Governor's Leadership Award is given each year to three undergraduate students who have demonstrated a strong commitment to innovative social change and the promotion of women's leadership.

Tomorrow evening, Gov. Whitman will attend a fund raiser for Congressman Bob Franks.
