**Title Historical Note**

Title 15A, formerly Department of the Public Advocate, contained the rules of the Division of Public Interest Advocacy and rules regarding the organization of the Department, adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27E-1 et seq. and 52:14B-4(b). Chapter 1, Public Interest Advocacy, was adopted as R.1977 d. 362, effective September 23, 1977. See: 9 N.J.R.

347(a), 9 N.J.R. 541(b). Chapter 2, Organizational Rules, was adopted as R.1990 d. 56, effective December 27, 1989. See: 22 N.J.R. 557(a). Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27E-50 et al. (P.L.1994, c. 58), the Department of the Public Advocate was abolished, effective July 1, 1994, and its rules concerning organization, function, practice and procedure were rendered "null and of no effect."
