CHRONIC PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

This report was prepared from the New Jersey Relief Census submitted by 409 municipalities of the State which represent 86.5% of the State population (1930 Census) and 91.0% of the relief population on November 30, 1937.

The cases reported in the Census were classified as to employment status as follows:

In cases classified as unemployable and covering 24,907 persons there were 11,993 persons reported with chronic physical disabilities or 48.2% of the persons in the unemployable cases.

In the cases classified as employable and covering 127,558 persons, there were 9,232 persons reported as having chronic physical disabilities or 7.2% of the persons in the employable cases.

How these chronic physical disabilities effect the degree of dependency is shown as follows:

The cases classified as unemployable due to chronic physical disabilities contain no person who is able to assume financial responsibility for care of the case and it can be assumed, therefore, that the chronic physical disability will result in long term dependency of the persons so disabled.

In the cases classified as employable, in which there are persons with chronic physical disabilities, there are persons who are able to assume the financial responsibility for the care of the case, in whole or part, when they are employed.

These cases are on relief only during intervals of unemployment, or underemployment and are separated from the relief rolls when the income received in the case meets or exceeds the family relief budget. If they are to maintain themselves, after separation from relief, on the equivalent of the relief budget, they may be considered as medically indigent. They are not eligible for health service, through the Department of Public Welfare in most cities, when they are not receiving other types of relief.

The tables attached hereto cover the age, sex, race and type of physical disability in both employable and unemployable relief cases. Disabilities were classified in accordance with the "diagnosis" list attached hereto. This list was used by the New Jersey Department of Institutions and Agencies in connection with their "Report on Chronic Disease in New Jersey", issued in May 1932. 2/

- 1/ An employable case is one containing one or more persons over 16 and under 65 years of age, physically and mentally able to work and not needed at home to care for minors or invalids.
- 2/ This study excludes Pulmonary Tuberculosis, which is included in tables attached hereto.
