Trenton, NJ – Today, Governor Chris Christie released the following statement regarding General Glenn Rieth's resignation:

"Last week General Glenn Rieth offered his resignation as Adjutant General of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs which I accepted. He has served the State of New Jersey and the United States Army for over 30 years and will be retiring effective December 15.

"I thank General Rieth for dedicating his career to his state and country, including nearly 10 years as New Jersey's Adjutant General. This is obviously a difficult time for his family and General Rieth did the right thing by stepping down to address this as a personal matter."
