The Office of Business Advocacy's objective is to cut red tape and get solutions to permit problems. OBA will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of the state permits required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit applications.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Schedule "OVER THE COUNTER" processing for permits meeting appropriate criteria.

## OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

### I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, CN 029, Trenton, N.J. 08625.

### II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, CN 401, Trenton, N.J. 08625.

### III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 4429

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, CN 029, Trenton, N.J. 08625.

All DEP Public Hearings, Administrative Hearings, and DEP  
Events of Public Interest are open to the public.

DEP Events of Public Interest include: public hearings, council meetings, workshops, public information meetings, and exams.

Public Hearings (Quasi - Legislative) - are held for the purpose of obtaining input and reaction to a proposed rule, regulation, or new program. Some hearings may be mandated by law. Generally their scope of impact is statewide, or of broad general interest.

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal. Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

March 1--COMPANY ORDERED TO CONNECT TO SEWER SYSTEM--DEP's Division of Water Resources issued an Administrative Order to Anchor Thread Company of Hamilton Township (Mercer County). It orders the company to connect their industrial wastewater into the Hamilton Township sewerage system within 60 days of availability to the system.

\* \* \* \*

March 3--CIVIL PENALTIES ASSESSED FOR WATER POLLUTION--DEP's Division of Water Resources recently issued two Administrative Orders with Civil Penalty Assessments, totaling \$12,500, to Fountainhead Park, Inc. in Jackson Township (Ocean County) and to Simmons' Oldsmobile, Inc. in Ramsey (Bergen County). Fountainhead Park was fined for failure to receive state and local permits and approvals for an on-site sewerage collection system. The Simmons firm was fined for illegal discharges into the groundwaters of the state.

March 4--PUBLIC HEARING ON COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM--David N. Kinsey, Director of DEP's Division of Coastal Resources, announced that a public meeting will be held in Toms River (Ocean County) on March 9 to receive public comment on New Jersey's Coastal Management Program.

\* \* \* \*

March 4--WATER RESOURCES OUTLINES ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS--DEP's Division of Water Resources announced the signing of an Administrative Consent Order with the Borough of Lincoln Park (Morris County) intended to assure an adequate potable water supply for the borough's residents. Also, the division issued an Administrative Order against Accurate Forming Division of Tyco Laboratories, Inc. of Hamburg (Sussex County) for illegally discharging hazardous chemicals into the groundwater under their facility and into the Wallkill River.

March 8--PUBLIC MEETING SCHEDULED ON D&R CANAL PROJECT--DEP Commissioner Hughey, who is chairman of the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, announced that three public information meetings will be held to gather public comment on development plans for the removal and disposal of flow restricting sediment from the Delaware and Raritan (D&R) Canal water system. The meetings will be held on March 16 in Trenton, March 17 in Lambertville and March 18 in Princeton Township.

March 8--ASSISTANT COMMISSIONERS NAMED--DEP Commissioner Robert Hughey announced the appointment of Helen C. Fenske of Morris County as the Department's Assistant Commissioner for Natural Resources, and Donald T. Graham of Ocean County, as Assistant Commissioner for Regulatory and Governmental Affairs.

March 12--LIFEGUARD POSITIONS OPEN AT STATE PARKS--DEP is seeking applicants for lifeguard positions at the state's 18 inland and ocean beach parks this summer. Of the 180 lifeguard jobs, about half will be filled by eligible applicants who pass the required tests and half will be filled by returning guards. Eagle's Nest Campground is a proposed condominium campground intended for seasonal use by self-contained recreational vehicles. The applicant will generate and discharge 56,200 gallons per day (GPD) of domestic sewage from 562 camp sites to a 70,000 GPD capacity extended aeration filtration treatment system discharging to a 393,400 gallon capacity surface impoundment and a 9.0 acre spray irrigation field.

Exxon Research and Engineering Company, an affiliate of Exxon Corporation, is the primary research and engineering unit. The discharge, located on the property of Exxon, is to the ground waters of the State, to the Allentown Formation and the Califon Member of the Leithsville Formation, both of Cambrian Age. Exxon will generate approximately 150,000 gallons per day (GPD) of wastewater, 30,000 GPD of sanitary wastewater and 120,000 GPD of process wastewater.
