SUBJECT: First Amended State Fiscal Year ("SFY") 2024 Interim Transportation Financing Program Project Priority List ("SFY2024 **1st Amended** Transportation Bank PPL")

The New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (the "I-Bank") and the New Jersey Department of Transportation (the "NJDOT") are pleased to present the **SFY2024 1st Amended** Transportation Financing Program Project Priority List (the "PPL") to the New Jersey State Legislature pursuant to the New Jersey Infrastructure Trust Act N.J.S.A. 58:11 B-1 et seq. ("the Act"). The New Jersey Transportation Infrastructure Financing Program (the "Transportation Bank") is a joint financing program between the I-Bank and the NJDOT. The PPL is a compilation of all eligible projects for which an application has been submitted to the Transportation Bank for financing on or before June 30, 2023, and which have not already received long-term financing. The Act authorizes the I-Bank to amend the PPL four times during the State fiscal year. The PPL for SFY2024 was originally submitted to the Legislature in January 2023, in preparation for the upcoming program year. This submission serves as the first such amendment for SFY2024.

The Act established the Transportation Bank to make low interest loans for local transportation infrastructure projects with a mission of reducing the cost of financing critical transportation projects for New Jersey counties and municipalities.

The SFY2024 **1st Amended** Transportation Bank PPL, set forth in **Appendix A**, consists of 26 projects with an estimated total value of **\$129.3 million** with a breakdown as follows:

- Twenty (20) of the twenty-six (26) projects, totaling an estimated \$85.7 million, have been allocated funds and are currently in the design or construction phase of the project.
- One (1) project, with an estimated value of \$1.5 million, was allocated funds for this 1st quarter of SFY2024 under the new Transportation Bank Bipartisan Infrastructure Law ("BIL") match incentive program which finances a Disadvantaged Community's match requirement to receive federal BIL grant funds.
- Two (2) projects, with an estimated total value of \$4.8 million, were re-allocated funds based on the criteria set forth in the current Project Priority Report.
- Total current allocations amount to approximately **\$92.1 million**.
- Three (3) projects, totaling an estimated \$37.3 million, have submitted applications and are awaiting allocation.
