

## NOTICE TO THE BAR

### 2006 ANNUAL ASSESSMENT

The Supreme Court of New Jersey having ruled on the Disciplinary Oversight Committee ("DOC") and New Jersey Lawyers Assistance Program ("NJLAP") budgets for 2006, the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection ("Fund") is now in a position to conduct the assessment for the calendar year 2006. As always, the money collected through the assessment will support the Fund, the disciplinary process, and the NJLAP. The breakdown for 2006 is as follows:

Billing notices will be mailed in mid March. The deadline for response to the billing is April 28, 2006. Please telephone the Fund at (609) 292-8079 if you have not received your billing form by April 7, 2006. Timely payment will avert the **\$40 late fee**.

Please be sure to return the **entire original form**. The form consists of three separate portions with three distinct purposes. For example, different addresses are sought on the various portions of the form. Questions regarding any portion of the form should be directed to the corresponding telephone number displayed on that portion.

Since the billing address is the one that shows through the window envelope, it is **crucial** (and required by *R. 1:28-2*) that an effective mailing address be kept current with the Fund.
