**Title 58. WATERS AND WATER SUPPLY**

**Chapter 11. WATER AND SEWERAGE PLANTS AND SYSTEMS  
IN GENERAL**

**Article 4. INFORMATION TO STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.**

**58:11-12. Information to be furnished when called for.** Whoever possesses, uses, owns, leases or controls a water supply or sewerage system or a plant for the purification or treatment of water, sewage or industrial wastes shall furnish to the director of the state department of health such information relating to the construction and operation of any such system or plant as may be called for from time to time by the director.

**58:11-13. Penalty for refusing information.** Whoever refuses or fails to furnish said director with any information so requested by him, within the time specified in such request, shall be deemed to have violated this article and shall be subject to a penalty of one hundred dollars to be recovered in an action at law at the suit of the department. All moneys so recovered shall be paid into the state treasury.
