## LEGAL BASIS FOR PUBLIC SERVICE IN NEW JERSEY — 1970

### **AREA LIBRARY:**

A headquarters library under contract with the State for specialized services to libraries within a given geographic area. There are 21 Area Libraries.

### **ASSOCIATION LIBRARY:**

One established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. There are 129 association libraries. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the use of the public are included in this publication.

### **COUNTY LIBRARY:**

One established by law following a county-wide referendum passed by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission composed of 5 members appointed by the Freeholders. There are 13 county libraries.

### **FEDERATION:**

Any number of independently established libraries voluntarily united to develop cooperative free public library services. Each member library retains complete institutional independence but enters into contracts or service agreements with other members to achieve the joint services agreed upon by the governing bodies of the respective libraries. There are two federation of libraries in New Jersey whose members retain identity as municipal libraries.

### **JOINT LIBRARY:**

One established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities. There are three joint libraries.

### **MUNICIPAL LIBRARY:**

One established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a 7 member board appointed by the mayor which must include the mayor and the superintendent of schools. There are 200 municipal libraries.

### **REGIONAL LIBRARY:**

One established by law following resolution adopted by the boards of chosen freeholders of 2 or more counties. It is governed by a board of trustees appointed by the boards of freeholders of the participating counties. There are no regional libraries to date.

These statistics are compiled from reports submitted by individual libraries for calendar year 1970. Additional data and processing has been supplied as indicated below. Where a library is supported by more than one municipality, figures shown represent combined municipalities.

<u>Column</u>	<u>Explanation</u>
<b>Library Name</b>	Generally the municipality name identifies a public library. Where a library name differs from that of the municipality, the library name is inserted in parentheses under the name of the municipality.
<b>Estimated Population Served</b>	Source: New Jersey Population Estimates — 1970 by New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry, Office of Business Economics. Total population of New Jersey as of July 1, 1970 was estimated at 7,194,455. Population served by local libraries is somewhat less at 7,085,985. The remainder of the population, or 108,470 reside in unserved municipalities of counties without a county library.
<b>Type</b>	The following letters are used to indicate type of library: A — Association; J — Joint Library; and M — Municipal Library. County Libraries are identified by name but are not indicated in this column. Area Libraries are indicated by an asterisk before library name.
<b>Equalized Valuation</b>	Source: Table of Equalized Valuation by New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Taxation — 1970 Conformed Copy. Figures are shown to the nearest thousand. Equalized Valuation of unserved municipalities not included.
<b>Local Tax Support</b>	Tax support is shown as reported by individual libraries. Calculation of State Aid is made on basis of tax support shown in municipal budget.
<b>Per Capita State Aid</b>	Amounts shown represent State Aid sent in October 1970 to municipalities supporting local libraries. County totals represent the entire amount of Per Capita State Aid in return for local official support of libraries. Some county totals are larger than the sum for the libraries listed. State Aid to Area Libraries, Research Libraries and Incentive Grants are not shown in this column.
<b>Per Capita Expenditures</b>	Derived from total expenditures divided by the estimated population served. For County member libraries, per capita expenditures including library dedicated tax is also shown.
<b>Staff</b>	Figures appearing under column Professional With Degree represent individual librarians who hold a fifth year degree in library science. Figures appearing under Professional and Clerical staff F.T.E. (Full Time Equivalents) represent one or more employed in a job for at least one-half full-time. Where less than half-time employment during work week was reported no credit is given under F.T.E. Volunteers are indicated under column headed vol.
<b>Volumes Owned</b>	Figure represents books reported as owned at the end of 1970. In the case of county member libraries books reported as supplied by the County Library on extended long term loan are included here.
<b>Subscribed Periodicals</b>	Figure shows reported number of titles under Subscription including newspapers and magazines other than annuals.
<b>Hours Open Per Week</b>	The number of hours the main library was open for public service during the major part of 1970 is shown. Figures appearing under Totals represents averages.
<b>Per Capita Books In Library</b>	Derived from volumes in library divided by estimated population served.
<b>Unreported Items</b>	Where information requested of a reporting library was not provided and N.R. is inserted in the column to indicated Not Reported.
