The region's total passenger volume grew 3.2 percent (+354,267 passengers) to a record 11.515 million travelers. The domestic sector paced growth a solid 4.6 percent rise (+329,979 passengers) and a record 7.468 million passengers. International passengers expanded at a modest 0.6 percent rate (+24,288 passengers), and reached a record 4.048 million travelers. Carriers increased their total seat capacity by 3.4 percent. Domestic seats set the tempo with a 5.4 percent gain, as international seats inched up 0.04 percent. Growth was powered by strong economic performance, solid seat capacity expansion and competitive prices. The freight momentum continues as the region's total cargo grew by 4 percent (+7,144 tons). International cargo, with a 64 percent share of the region's total cargo activity, led growth with a 3.5 percent gain (+4,170 tons). Domestic cargo expanded by 4.9 percent (+2,974 tons).
