

NOTICE TO THE BAR
BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS – PROCESSING FEES FOR
CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS

As of July 1, 2019, the processing fee assessed in conjunction with credit card payments to the Board of Bar Examiners will be calculated based on a percentage of the transaction amount. The Supreme Court approved this percentage-based processing fee, which is part of the Judiciary's implementation of the State contract for credit card processing services.

Credit card payments, where applicable, will continue to be accepted using VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. Payments made to the Board of Bar Examiners by certified or corporate check or money order will continue to be accepted without the additional fee.

The online customer payment pages for credit card transactions previously were modified as part of the rollout of the new credit card system.
