NEW JERSEY RELIEF CENSUS, NOVEMBER 30, 1937

SPECIAL STUDIES

This report has been prepared to provide more detailed data on the relief population than was reported in the preliminary census releases dated April, May, July, September, October.

The report is based upon the information contained in the New Jersey Relief Census which was prepared from the records in municipal relief offices and submitted to the Financial Assistance Commission by municipal relief administrators.

Persons receiving benefits from the Division of Old Age Assistance, State Board of Children's Guardians and Blind Commission were included in the census when other persons in the cases were receiving direct relief.

The totals shown on the following tables differ slightly from those reported in previous releases, as additional census information was received after the preliminary reports were prepared.
