NOTICE RE REGULATIONS

Enclosed is the following revised regulation which was adopted by the State Board of Agriculture on July 27, 1960:

3:4-4.1 Regulations for State Seal of Quality White Potatoes

This should be inserted in the book of regulations of the Department of Agriculture which was sent to you, and the old regulation concerned with the above topic removed and destroyed.

3:4-4.1 Regulations for State Seal of Quality White Potatoes

Source

Only white potatoes produced in the State of New Jersey may be identified by the State Seal of Quality.

Grade

Each lot of potatoes packed as State Seal of Quality shall be Federal-State inspected and certified as meeting the requirements of U. S. No. 1 Grade - Size A, or better. The minimum diameter shall be not less than 2 inches and the maximum diameter not more than 4 inches. Each lot shall be fairly clean and fairly well matured, unless specified as moderately skinned; as defined in the United States Standards for Potatoes.

Seals

The State Seal of Quality bags and tags shall be obtained only at sources approved by the New Jersey Department of Agriculture.

Use of Seals

The use of the State Seal of Quality is available to any person, firm or corporation for use in marketing white potatoes who will comply with these regulations and any instructions issued therewith.

Application and Contract

No person, firm or corporation shall use the State Seal of Quality in connection with the grading and labeling of white potatoes unless there is in force an official agreement between the applicant and the New Jersey Department of Agriculture.

License

The Secretary of Agriculture shall issue a license to qualified applicants to use the State Seal of Quality on packages containing white potatoes produced within the State of New Jersey which meet the standards and grade established.

The Secretary of Agriculture shall issue a license to buy and sell bags and tags bearing the imprint of the New Jersey State Seal of Quality to dealers who sign an official agreement with the New Jersey Department of Agriculture.

The Secretary of Agriculture shall issue a license to make and imprint on bags and tags the State Seal of Quality for potatoes to manufacturers who sign an official agreement with the New Jersey Department of Agriculture.

Packages

Each package, at the time of inspection and before shipment or sale shall have, in letters not less than 3/8 inches in height, the name and address of the packer.

Penalties

Violation of any of the applicable laws and regulations shall be subject to penalty by revocation of the license to use the State Seal of Quality.

This revised regulation,
adopted July 27, 1960
supersedes the previous
regulation of March 24, 1960.
