Veterans Day Ceremony at Doyle Cemetery




The Brig. Gen. William C. Doyle Veterans Memorial Cemetery was the site for the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs' annual Veterans Day Ceremony on Nov. 11. Third District Congressman Jon Runyan was the keynote speaker joining Raymond Zawacki, Deputy Commissioner for Veterans Affairs along with senior military and veterans' leaders at the ceremony. The event included a flag Retirement Service, wherein the ashes of 3,215 flags were entombed.

The Cemetery, which is New Jersey's sole state-operated veterans' cemetery, was dedicated in 1986, and is managed by the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. The Doyle Cemetery is the busiest state veteran cemetery in the nation, averaging 2,750 interments each year. It is the final resting place for more than 43,000 veterans and family members.
