Acting Governor Guadagno Highlights Veterans' Services at Disabled American Veterans Convention

Trenton, NJ - Applauding the service of New Jersey's veterans, Acting Governor Kim Guadagno today delivered remarks at the 94th Annual Convention of the Disabled American Veterans of New Jersey (DAVNJ) in Atlantic City.

During her remarks, the Acting Governor called for greater awareness and support for veterans' issues, including treatment for Posttraumatic Stress Disorder and access to necessary health care.

"There is no single solution, and there is no one person who can make every change necessary. We must work together to ensure that our veterans' system of care continuously strives to match the needs of our current and future veterans," said Acting Governor Guadagno. "As you advocate for these changes on behalf of all veterans, you are once again on the front lines. And that is why it was so important for me to join you today as a partner in your efforts."

DAVNJ is a service organization dedicated to advocating for and assisting all disabled veterans in receiving the benefits for which they qualify. The Acting Governor's participation in the event reaffirms the Administration's commitment to support New Jersey's more than 400,000 current veterans as well as its future veterans.
