Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The COVID-19 crisis continues to affect our region's domestic and international air passenger traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 86.8 percent year-over-year in the month of July – down 11.32 million travelers. Accounting for over 60 percent of the region's total air traveler volume, the domestic sector recorded an 83 percent plunge – down 6.641 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 86.8 percent – down 4.68 million travelers. Driven by the international sector's fifth straight monthly double-digit decline (-40.1 percent/-43,441 short tons), the region's total air freight volume fell 17.2 percent (-30,312 short tons). Domestic cargo was more resilient, recording its first double-digit improvement since May 2019 (+19.3 percent), as all four airports grew their domestic cargo traffic by jointly handling 13,129 additional short tons.
