Register Ready | NJ Office of Emergency Management



Register Ready is a confidential and secure database designed to help emergency managers and first responders plan for and support people who have disabilities and access and functional needs who may need assistance in the event of a disaster. Permanent and seasonal New Jersey residents with DAFN should register if they might need help evacuating, sheltering in place or at a public shelter, or require special emergency assistance. Individuals with a temporary disability, such as a high-risk pregnancy or other serious medical condition, are also encouraged to register.

Get Flood Insured | National Flood Insurance Program



The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), overseen by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), provides flood insurance to property owners, renters and businesses to reduce the cost of future flood damage. The NFIP also works with communities to adopt and enforce floodplain

management regulations to lessen the impact of future flood damage.

Did you know that most property insurance policies do not cover flood damage? Just one inch of flood water can cause more than \$25,000 in damage to your home.
