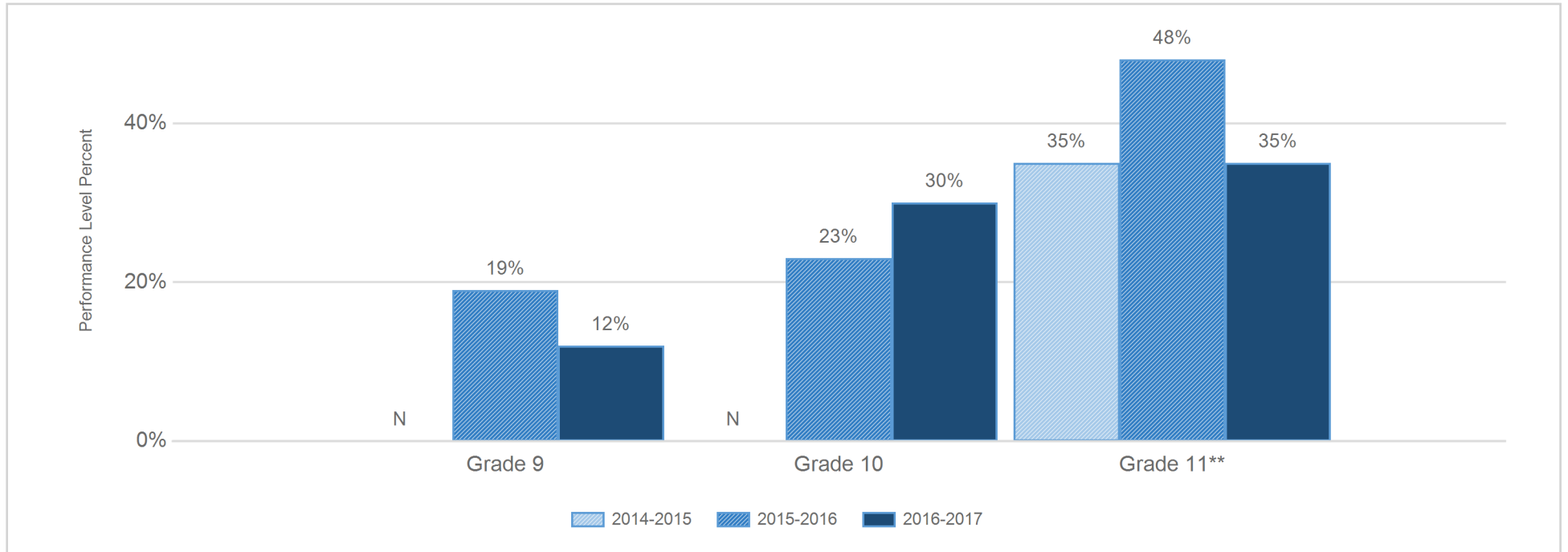

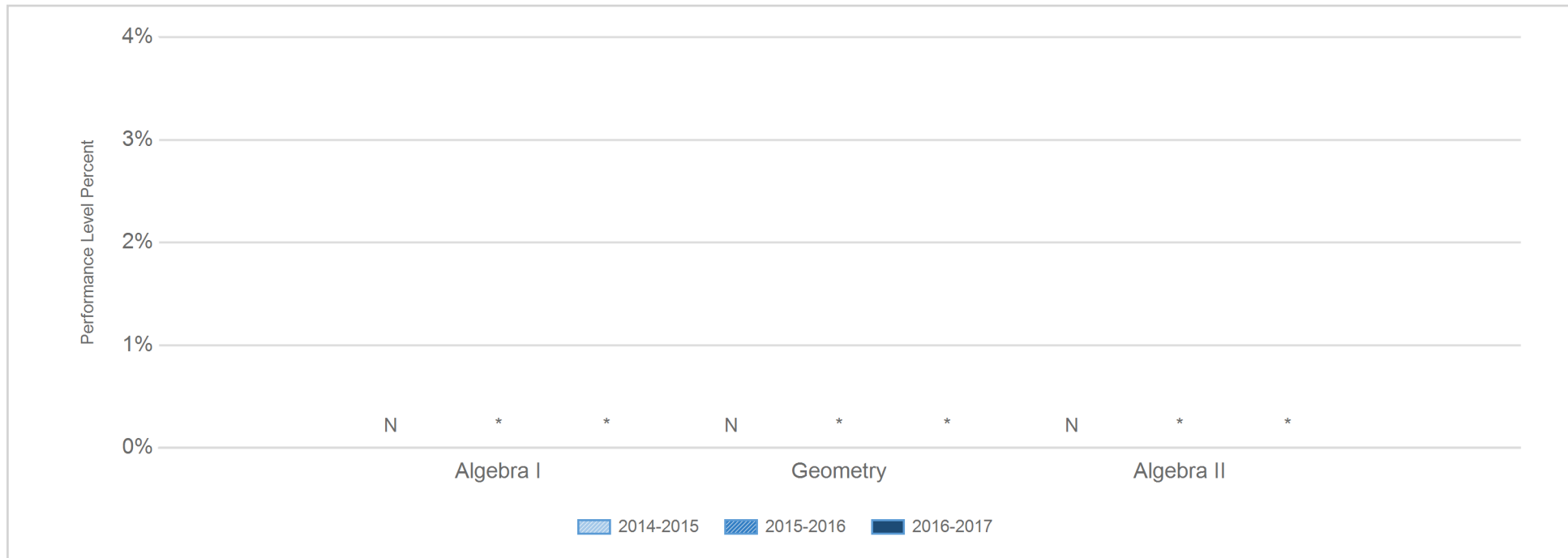

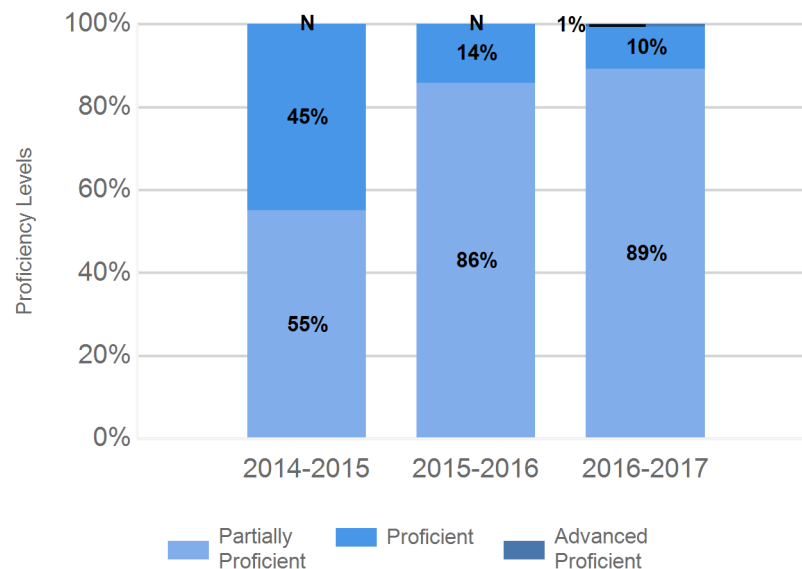

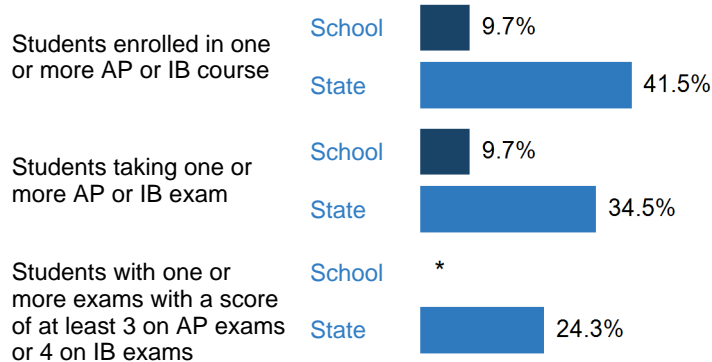

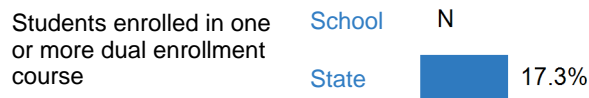

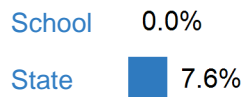

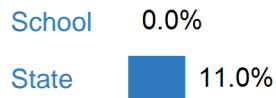
CTE Participants

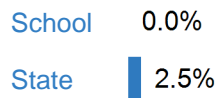

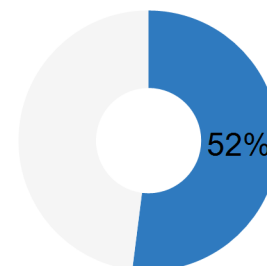

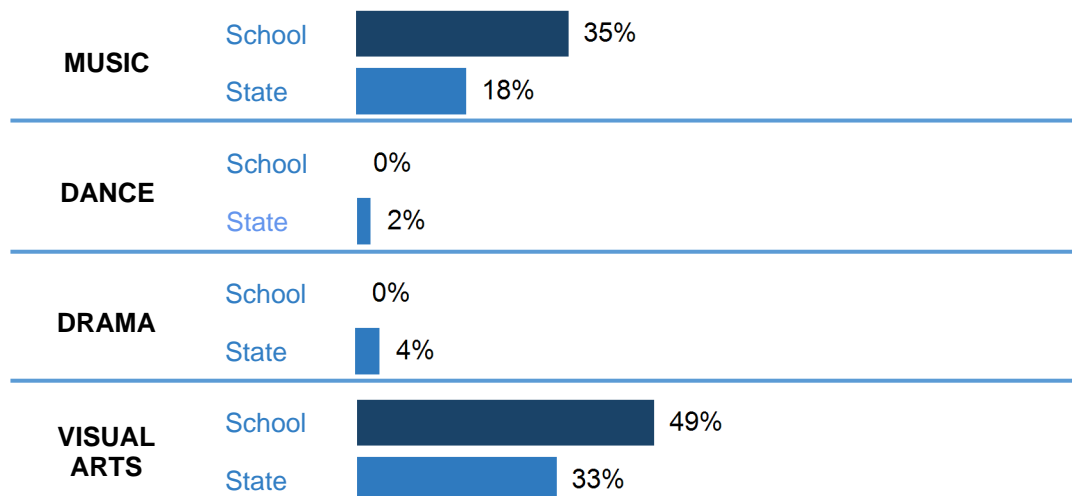

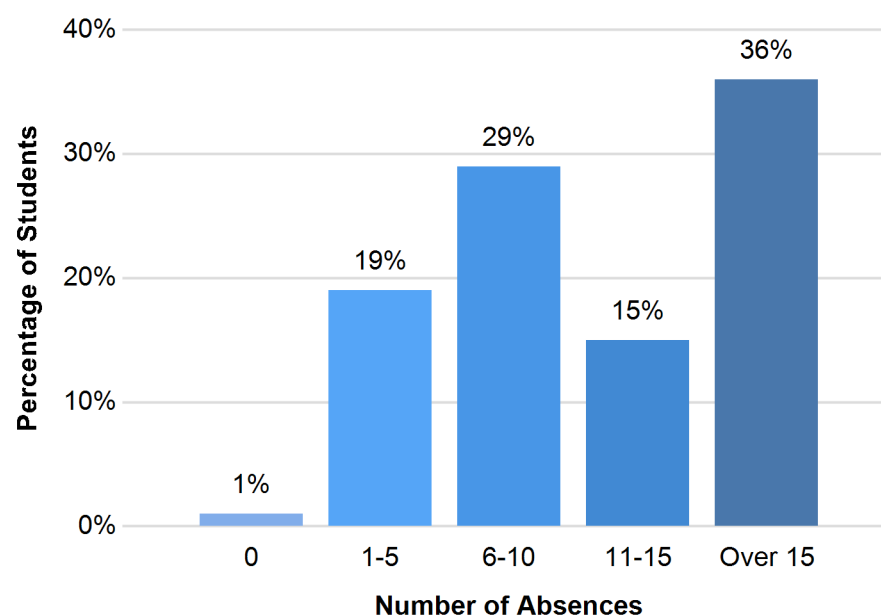

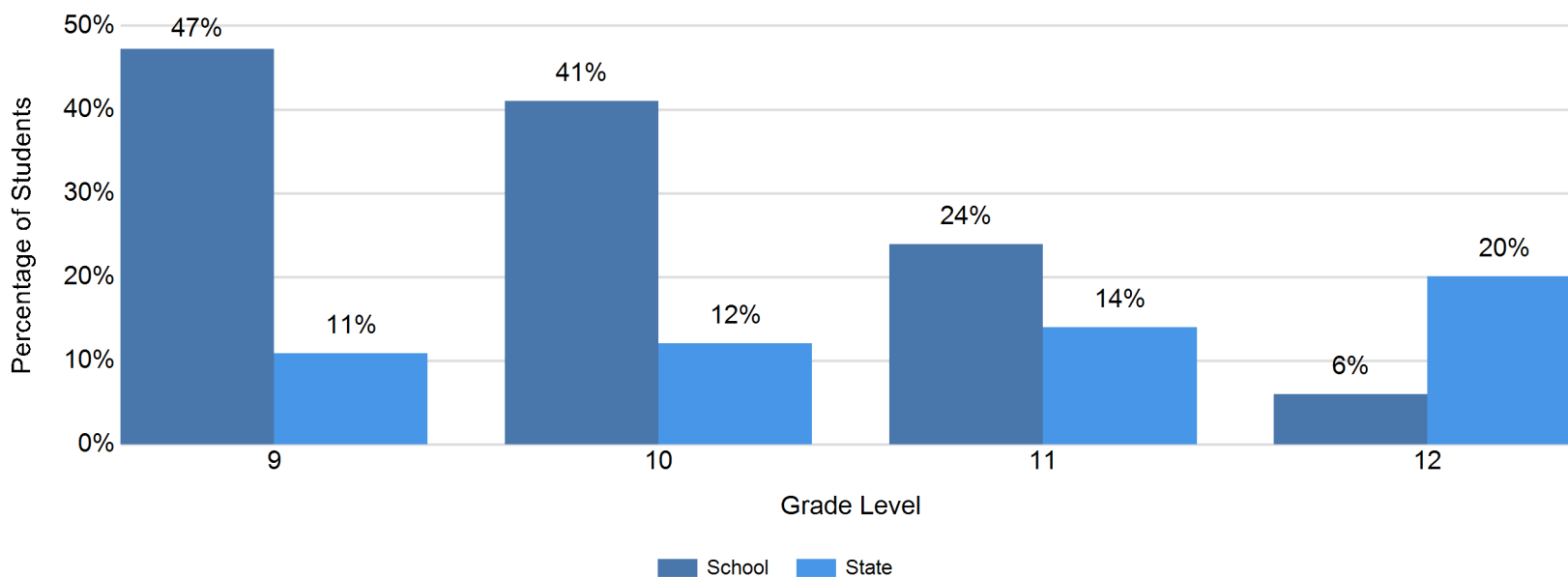

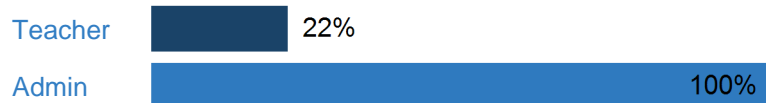
Teachers and Administrators - Level of Education

 <p>Staff and Professional Learning:</p>	<p>All new teachers begin a five-week training program with People's Prep leaders in August. All People's Prep teachers are assigned to a teacher coach who observes them and gives them feedback on a weekly basis. Pathways to teacher leadership include membership on the Instructional Leadership Team or the Cultural Leadership Team. All teachers meet weekly for department-level training, student support meetings, and professional development sessions.</p>
 <p>Postsecondary Information:</p>	<p>PPCS is a free, public, college prep high school. All students take a four-year college prep course called Futures and receive weekly academic advising. College advising begins in the 9th grade. Students attend at least four college trips a year, which are sponsored by People's Prep. 12th graders attend a summer session, which focuses on completing the Common Application. 12th graders take a credit-bearing ACT prep course, 100% apply to a four-year college, and 85% of graduates attend college.</p>
 <p>Student Supports and Services:</p>	<p>After school office hours, Wednesday evening office hours, and Saturday Sessions are open to students who need additional academic support. Staff members coordinate interventions for students who are struggling at weekly student support meetings. People's Prep employs multiple mental health workers, and council coaches provide mentorship for all students. Counseling, small-group tutoring sessions, and small-group classes are offered for students with disabilities.</p>
 <p>Student Health and Wellness:</p>	<p>Students participate in physical education classes each year at People's Prep. They also take a health class each year that helps to promote health and wellness.</p>
