**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
JULY 1998**

Comparing counts for July 31, 1998 with those on July 31, 1997, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

7% increase from 27,375 to 29,280 for the jurisdictional population;
(state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
-30% decrease from 4,422 to 3,103 for state inmates in county facilities;
19% increase from 18,090 to 21,439 for the prison complex;
-3% decrease from 4,863 to 4,738 for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

2% increase from 1,445 to 1,475 for total admissions.

RELEASES

-14% decrease from 1,329 to 1,144 for total releases;
-23% decrease from 954 to 732 for male parole releases;
10% increase from 81 to 89 for female parole releases;
-21% decrease from 1,035 to 821 for total parole releases;
10% increase from 294 to 323 for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
