Meeting Highlights Trade Relationship Between China and New Jersey

Trenton, NJ – Acting Governor Guadagno today welcomed Ambassador Zhang Qiyue, Chinese Consul General in New York, to the State House in Trenton.

China is New Jersey's 7th-largest trading partner. In 2014, New Jersey exported approximately \$1.43 billion in goods to China. New Jersey also has Sister-State Agreements with Shandong Province and Zhejiang Province in China.

Acting Governor Guadagno was joined by Senator Gerald Cardinale (R-Bergen and Passaic) and Senator Thomas H. Kean, Jr. (R-Morris, Somerset and Union), among others.
