Chapter Historical Note

Chapter 18 was originally filed and became effective prior to September 1, 1969, as Chapter VI of the State Sanitary Code, Boarding Homes for Children, under the authority of N.J.S.A. 26:1A-7. The responsibility for these facilities was transferred from the Department of Health to the Department of Human Services by N.J.S.A. 30. The Department

of Health repealed the rules at N.J.A.C. 8:18, effective April 4, 1983, by R.1983 d.101. See: 14 N.J.R. 1436(b), 15 N.J.R. 544(a).

New Rules describing the Catastrophic Illness in Children Relief Fund Program were filed as R.1989 d.557, effective November 7, 1989. See: 21 N.J.R. 1781(a), 21 N.J.R. 3501(a).
