## Teterboro & regional satellite airport summaries

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Passenger traffic rose 3.5% with Newark Liberty taking the lead with 7.3% growth, with JFK at 3.2% and LGA showing a (1.3%) drop. Even the bad news is good, relative to ATA stats showing a (4.8%) August decline -giving the region an +8% point share gap. Freight traffic declined (7.1%). We believe the negative acrue almost entirely to the great blackout of 2003 on August 14-15.
