SUBJECT: Medicaid/NJ KidCare Eligibility Identification Cards

This is a follow-up to Medicaid Communication 98-14 which advised that the Division would be issuing newly formatted Medicaid Eligibility Identification Cards in June of 1998. Due to production difficulties, issuance of the new cards was delayed.

The Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services is pleased to announce that beginning in January 1999, cards for all programs except AFDC/TANF, will be printed in a standard format. The NJ KidCare cards will be distinguished by their cranberry color, while all other cards produced by the Division will remain blue.

The most notable difference in the new format of the cards is that the address of the beneficiary will be placed only on the outside of the card (which is folded into thirds). In addition, a service package identifier is included on the new card. The Division is in the process of developing a template which will assist with initial and replacement cards. The Social Security number of the beneficiary will no longer appear on the card.
