Comparing counts for December 31, 1998 with those on December 31, 1997, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

10% increase	from	27,756	to	30,434	for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
2% increase	from	3,753	to	3,811	for state inmates in county facilities;
15% increase	from	18,961	to	21,845	for the prison complex;
-5% decrease	from	5,042	to	4,778	for the youth facilities.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
