Governor Whitman to Address National Press Club in Washington, D.C.

New Jersey Gov. Christie Whitman will deliver the keynote address to the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. tomorrow and will speak to the Nature Conservancy and the Conference of Conservative Women Parliamentarians.

Also while in Washington, the Governor will meet privately with House Speaker Dennis Hastert. She will be available to the press following the meeting.

Gov. Whitman will deliver a speech titled "Republicans, Democrats, Feminists and Post-Impeachment Politics." The Governor will discuss the work governors across the nation have done to move the nation forward while Washington lost itself in the impeachment process.

Governor Whitman will speak about how those most closely identified with the impeachment process, from the feminist movement to the Capitol Hill crowd, ended up being the big losers.

The National Press Club lunch begins at 12:30 p.m. The speech begins at 1 p.m. Press covering the event may attend the lunch for free.

Also during her visit to Washington, Gov. Whitman will deliver the keynote address and receive an award from the Nature Conservancy for her mission to preserve 1 million acres of open space and farmland in the Garden State.

The Governor will also address the International Conference of Conservative Women Parliamentarians.
