While many will characterize 2012 as a year of unrealized and unmet expectations, it was yet another year of growth for our airports. With a 3.3 % gain in 2012, our region's passenger traffic has enjoyed three successive annual gains. Domestic traffic grew 3.2%. International traffic also grew 3.4% and propelled the levels to a new record of 37.7 million passengers. The region's passenger growth benefited from several factors, including a mild winter compared to blizzard conditions a year ago, an extra leapyear day in February, record-breaking passenger growth in August. Cargo remained weak as it fell 6% in 2012.
