For the ninth year in a row, the region's overall traffic set an all-time mark as the airports handled 138.8 million passengers, a 4.5 percent gain, or an additional 5.6 million passengers over 2017. Additionally, we served 50.5 million international passengers, breaking the all-time international passenger traffic record set in 2017, and the first time we surpassed 50 million international travelers regionally. The 88.3 million domestic passengers also eclipsed the previous mark set in 2017 by 3.2 million. With a gain of 2.8 percent, cargo grew for the fifth consecutive year, marking the first time it has achieved this feat since a 1987-1997 streak. The domestic sector, which makes up 36 percent of the region's cargo, led growth with a net addition of 37,935 tons, for a growth of 4.7 percent, while the international sector struggled but still showed a gain of 1.7 percent.
