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**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
OCTOBER 1995**

Comparing counts for October 31, 1995 with those on October 31, 1994, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 11% increase from 24,644 to 27,405 for all institutions;
- 10% increase from 23,968 to 26,697 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 31% increase from 3,420 to 4,495 for county waiting;
- 18% increase from 885 to 1,043 for county contract and county assistance;
- 6% increase from 14,733 to 15,548 for the prison complex;
- 14% increase from 4,930 to 5,611 for the youth facilities; and
- 5% increase from 676 to 708 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 33% increase from 1,302 to 1,729 for total admissions;
- 35% increase from 1,192 to 1,608 for adults; and
- 10% increase from 110 to 121 for juveniles.

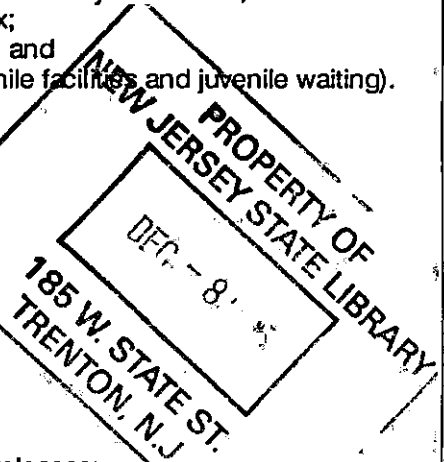
RELEASES

- -18% decrease from 1,369 to 1,118 for total releases;
- -31% decrease from 1,003 to 690 for adult male parole releases;
- -32% decrease from 111 to 75 for adult female parole releases;
- -31% decrease from 1,114 to 765 for total adult parole releases;
- 35% increase from 203 to 274 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 52% increase from 52 to 79 for juvenile releases.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
