

INTRODUCTION

The violence within the American domicile has been recognized for decades by elements of government and society with little done to correct the problem. Only recently has this phenomenon begun to receive the attention it deserves. In an effort to understand, identify and treat the incidents of abuse occurring in the home, the State of New Jersey, through its legislature, has provided the means to gain a meaningful insight into this issue.

In 1982, the Domestic Violence Act was instituted to protect battered victims and study the complex problems that spark such aggressive behavior. This legislation also provided the opportunity to identify the causes of violence in the home and put forth a more comprehensive effort to combat the crime of Domestic Violence.

Improvements since the implementation of the Domestic Violence Act are continuing. Pursuant to a change in N.J.S.A. 2C:25-24 enacted June 9, 1999, arrest data is presented by county. Domestic Violence restraining order violations are now captured and reported. Revised investigation and reporting procedures by the police; improved processing of domestic complaints by the courts; mandatory in-service training for police and court personnel have all enabled the victim to come forward and implement the constitutional rights granted to all Americans.

The following pages of narrative and graphics in this chapter are the result of gathered data displaying the complexities of domestic violence found within the State of New Jersey. It is through analysis of this data that, hopefully, the keys to preventing future violence can be found.

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DOMESTIC VIOLENCE STATISTICAL SUMMARY

Highlights of the 2011 domestic violence statistics are listed below:

- There were 70,311 domestic violence offenses reported by the police in 2011, a 5 percent decrease compared to the 74,244 reported in 2010.
- Murders increased 5 percent in 2011 (40) when compared to 2010 (38).
- Assaults accounted for 42 percent (29,743) and harassment accounted for 44 percent (30,974) of the reported offenses in 2011.
- Arrests were made in 31 percent (21,654) of the offenses reported for 2011, a decrease of 5 percent when compared to arrests made in 2010.
- The most frequent day of domestic violence occurrences was Sunday (12,096).
- For the twenty-ninth consecutive year, the most frequent hours of domestic violence incidents were between 8:00 p.m. and midnight, when 26 percent (18,074) of the offenses were reported.
- Children were involved or present during 31 percent of all domestic violence offenses occurring in 2011. Specifically, 5 percent (3,172) were involved and 26 percent (18,518) were present.
- Wives were the victims in 18 percent (12,317) and ex-wives were the victims in 3 percent (2,239) of the reported domestic violence offenses in 2011. Overall, females were victims in 76 percent (53,155) of all domestic violence offenses.
- The number of domestic violence complaints that had prior court orders issued against the offender decreased from 14,245 in 2010 to 13,099 in 2011. This is a decrease of 8 percent.
- Alcohol and/or drugs were involved in 26 percent (18,323) of the reported offenses occurring in 2011. Alcohol involvement alone accounted for 23 percent (16,365) of the total domestic violence offenses reported.
- Persons age 60 or over were victims in 4 percent (2,961) of all reported domestic violence offenses that occurred in 2011. Elderly were the victims in 15 percent (6) of the domestic violence murders (40).
- Domestic violence does not occur at a regular frequency, but when viewed as a ratio of its occurrence to a fixed time interval, one act of domestic violence would occur every 7 minutes and 29 seconds.
- Domestic violence offenses arising from a dating relationship accounted for 14 percent (10,124) of the state total.
- There were 2,962 total arrests involving domestic violence restraining orders reported by police in 2011. Of these, 1,804 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **only**, while 1,158 were arrests for violations of a restraining order **with** an offense arrest.

- Twenty-six percent (18,320) of all domestic violence complaints resulted in injury. This is a decrease of 5 percent when compared to the 19,169 that occurred in 2010.
- Of all the domestic violence offenses involving weapons (31,697, hands, fists, feet, etc. were used in 92 percent 29,177) of these offenses.
- Domestic violence offenses involving a gun decreased 2 percent when compared to 2010.
- Serious injuries were reported in 1,461 offenses, an increase of less than one-half of one percent when compared to the 1,459 reported in 2010.




- Assaults accounted for 34 percent (1,017) of all domestic violence offenses for victims 60 years old or over.
- Females age 60 or over were the victims in 63 percent (1,877) of the 2,961 elderly abuse offenses.
- Persons age 60 or over were the victims in 4 percent (2,961) of all the reported domestic violence offenses during this period.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE OFFENSES BY TIME OF DAY 2010/2011




- During 2011, 26 percent (18,074) of the reported domestic violence offenses occurred between 8:00 p.m. and 12 midnight.

- Sunday recorded the highest number of occurrences in 2011 with 12,096 offenses.
- During 2011, 34 percent (23,576) of the reported domestic violence offenses occurred during the weekend (Saturday and Sunday).

- In 2011, the highest number of domestic violence offenses occurred during the month of July.
- During 2011, the month with the lowest number of reported domestic violence offenses was February.
